

As we look ahead to 2023, there's plenty to wish for inside the ropes on the LPGA. With major championship venues like Pebble Beach and Baltusrol on the horizon, and the first-ever Solheim Cup set in Spain, the stages are ripe for epic drama.

Watching Lexi Thompson, Nelly Korda and Annika Sorenstam compete alongside the men at two silly season events in 2022 got the excitement levels revved up for a mixed-team format.

What we're wishing for in 2023:

#### **Ko qualifies for LPGA Hall of Fame**

It's honestly hard to believe that Lydia Ko only owns two major titles, and that the last one came in 2016. Now only two points shy of qualifying for the LPGA Hall of Fame, winning her third major title would put her over the line. Four of the five major championship

venues will be new to Ko in 2023. She won the 2015 Evian and the 2016 Chevron Championship.

#### Top men commit to mixed event

OK, so maybe asking for Tiger Woods to compete is a stretch. But a report that the QBE Shootout will adopt a mixed-team event format in 2023 is reason enough to think big. John Daly and Laura Davies won the final staging of the JCPenney Classic at Innisbrook in 1999, the most recent mixed-team event that was sponsored by the LPGA and PGA Tour. For the QBE to really shine, top male players need to commit, which could be tough given that its traditional dates are so close to Christmas and the PNC Championship. Let's hope the forthe-good-of-the-game spirit prevails.

#### Thompson finally wins US Women's Open – at Pebble Beach

Enough of the heartbreak! It's time

for Lexi Thompson to enjoy a new signature moment in her career. And what better place to do it than the first U.S. Women's Open ever held at Pebble Beach? Thompson has competed in every U.S. Women's Open since her debut in 2007, a remarkable stretch. The 27-year-old has competed in 16 Women's Opens, finishing tied for second in 2019 and that crushing third at Olympic in 2021. Time to flip the script.

#### **Sunday showdown in Spain**

Given the number of new faces we might see on both sides in 2023 at Finca Cortesin in Andalucia, Spain, it's possible the Americans might go into the Solheim Cup as, dare we say it, underdogs. Presently, there are seven European players in the top 30 of the Rolex Rankings and six Americans. Team Europe has won four of the last six contests. Add in the advantage of home soil, a feisty Suzann Pettersen at the helm and the new dynamite, best-friend pairing

of Sweden's Linn Grant and Maja Stark, and this could be the best Europe has ever looked on paper.

#### Someone dominates the season

It's time for a superstar to emerge on the LPGA. First-time winners are always fun, but to gain traction with new fans, the league needs a face. It's also critical that this person goes above-and-beyond in terms of promoting the tour and her brand. Could a healthy Nelly Korda, whom PGA Tour players raved about at the silly season events, be that face? Or will Jin Young Ko heal from the wrist injury and return to that Annika-like consistency? Could Ko put together another five-win season as she did in 2015? How will Atthaya Thitikul followup that sensational rookie year? At the midway point of 2022, Minjee Lee looked like she might be the next breakout star. There are options. Someone needs to step up and take this tour to the next level.

# 10-time Japan winner among a dozen

It's not often that an LPGA rookie rises to No. 1 in the world, but Atthaya Thitikul proved to be a special player last season. Will anyone be able to make such a strong showing in 2023?

The rookie class is again highly global. In fact, an American hasn't won the Louise Suggs Rolex Rookie of the Year Award since Paula Creamer in 2005.

There are a couple of American hot shots who made headlines before they graduated from elementary school in the 2023 rookie class. Could Lucy Li or Alexa Pano break that drought?

Here are a dozen LPGA rookies to keep an eye on in 2023:

## Lucy Li

Lucy Li made headlines when she competed in the 2014 U.S. Women's Open at Pinehurst, and now she's finally made it to the big show. The 20-year-old won twice on the Epson Tour and tied for 16th at the 2022 U.S. Women's Open at Pine Needles. Li led the Epson Tour in scoring at 69.389 and finished T-4 at the LPGA's Dana Open.

## Hae Ran Ryu

South Korea's Hae Ran Ryu took medalist honors at LPGA Q-Series, finishing at 29 under. The KLPGA player came into the event ranked 50th in the world and broke 70 in six of the eight rounds. The 21-year-old was the 2020 KLPGA Rookie of the Year and 2018 Korean Women's Amateur champion.

## Alexa Pano

Alexa Pano, 18, finished tied for 21st at LPGA Q-Series to earn her card. The former Netflix star, known for her role in the documentary "The Short Game," became the youngest golfer (11) to play a JLPGA Tour event at the 2016 Yonex La-

dies Open. Pano made the cut in 16 of 18 starts on the Epson Tour with five top-10 finishes last season.

## Minami Katsu

Minami Katsu became the youngest winner in JLPGA Tour history when she won the 2014 KKT Cup Vantelin Ladies Open at 15. A two-time major winner on the JLPGA, Katsu turned professional in 2017. She has won 10 times on the JLPGA and finished tied for eighth at last year's TOTO Japan Classic, which is co-sanctioned with the LPGA.

## Ines Laklalech

Everything Ines Laklalech does this season will be noteworthy as she's the first player from North Africa and the Arab region to earn LPGA status. Laklalech, who played at Wake Forest, hails from Casablanca and Morocco. The 25-year-old advanced through all three stages of LPGA qualifying. Earlier this season she won the LET's Lacoste Ladies Open de France, becoming that tour's first Moroccan, Arab and North African champion.

## Yuna Nishimura

Yuna Nishimura, 22, is a six-time winner on the Japan LPGA. She turned

professional in 2019 and has five five career LPGA starts, including a solofourth at the 2022 TOTO Japan Classic.

#### **Xiaowen Yin**

Xiaowen Yin was the youngest player to earn her card through the Epson Tour last season at 17. The Chinese player, who turned 18 in December, won back-to-back events on the Epson Tour over the summer en route to securing her card. Her highest World Amateur Golf Ranking was seventh.

#### **Jaravee Boonchant**

Bangkok native and former Duke Blue Devil made 13 cuts in 16 starts on the Epson Tour last season. Boonchant was a four-time All-American and had former teammate and current LPGA member Gina Kim on the bag at Q-Series. She won the 2022 Epson Tour Championship to close out the season.

## **Hyo Joon Jang**

This 19-year-old from Korea entered the Epson Tour Championship ranked 11th on the money list with \$74,202, just \$1,076 behind No. 10 Pano. Hyo Joon Jang's T-11 finish was enough to push her into the 10th spot, forcing Pano to head to Q-Series to earn her LPGA card.

## Natthakritta Vongtaveelap

The 20-year-old from Bangkok turned professional in November for the final stage of LPGA qualifying. She advanced through the first two stages as an amateur. She finished runner-up twice in the 2021 and 2022 Women's Amateur Asia-Pacific Championship.

## Grace Kim

A rookie on the Epson Tour last season, Grace Kim, 21, notched five top-10 finishes last season, including a victory



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
