NOTES ON REVISED AFFIDAVIT FORM

The 2015 Legislature enacted amendments to the Minnesota law which governs mortgage foreclosure by advertisement. Those amendments appear in Chapter 14 of the 2015 session laws. They are effective on July 1, 2015.

Most importantly, a new statute was added (§580.033) that specifies where a notice of foreclosure should be published, something that was ambiguous under prior law. This statute also requires that affidavits of publication issued by a newspaper must contain certain language related to the published foreclosure notice.

The affidavit of publication form above includes (in paragraph 5) the language called for by the new statute. The form also complies with the general requirements for affidavits of publication found in Minnesota Statute, §331.07. The form is drafted so that it can be used for any published notice, not just mortgage foreclosure notices; in other words, you don't need to use a different form for other kinds of notices.

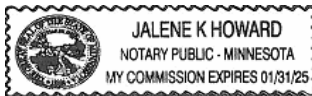

# Schmaltz, Crouse lift Coyotes

Nick Schmaltz scored the game-winner to extend his point streak, Lawson Crouse had a hat trick and the Arizona Coyotes beat the host Ottawa Senators 5-3 in the only game on the NHL schedule Monday night.

Schmaltz has 15 points in his past six games (six goals, nine assists) and Crouse's goals were varied: one at even strength, one on the power play and shorthanded. Barrett Hayton added an empty-net goal for the Coyotes and Scott Wedgewood made 40 saves to pick up his 10th win of the season.

Josh Norris had two goals for the Senators.

The Anaheim Ducks traded veteran defenseman Josh Manson to the Colorado Avalanche in exchange for defense prospect Drew Helleson and a second-round pick in the 2023 draft. Manson, 30, has been a stalwart on the Anaheim blue line since 2014.

AROUND THE HORN

**Tennis:** Rafael Nadal is still perfect in 2022, beating Daniel Evans 7-5, 6-3 in the third round of the BNP Paribas Open in Indian Wells, Calif., improving his record to 17-0 this year in pursuit of an ATP Tour-leading fourth title. Nadal tied Roger Federer (2018) and Pete Sampras (1997) for the third-best overall start to a season in the Open era. Daniil Medvedev's rise to No. 1 in the world came crashing down in a 4-6, 6-3, 6-1 loss to Gael Monfils — Medvedev needed to reach the quarterfinals to stay at the top.

**Soccer:** Manchester City played to a 0-0 draw vs. Crystal Palace, giving second-place Liverpool further hope of catching City for the Premier League lead. City led by 13 points two months ago, but that lead is down to four, and Liverpool plays twice before City's next game April 2.

# Jaguars going for extreme makeover

Let the dealing begin — if mostly unofficial.

The NFL's "legal tampering period" in free agency began Monday with a slew of deals even as many teams released veterans to clear salary cap space before the league's business year begins Wednesday.

Most aggressive was the worst team in the league, Jacksonville, which has the first overall selection in the draft next month for the second straight year, got busy early.

The Jaguars agreed to sign Arizona receiver Christian Kirk, Washington guard Brandon Scherff, Atlanta linebacker Foyesade Oluokun and New York Jets defensive tackle Folurunso "Foley" Fatukasi, according to a person familiar with negotiations.

Also agreeing to move on were New England cornerback J.C. Jackson to the Los Angeles Chargers; linebacker Haason Reddick from Carolina to Philadelphia; guard Laken Tomlinson from San Francisco to the Jets; running

back Chase Edmonds from Arizona to Miami; offensive lineman Ted Karras from New England to Cincinnati; offensive lineman Alex Cappa from Tampa Bay to Cincinnati; offensive lineman Rodger Saffold from Tennessee to Buffalo; and quarterback Mitch Trubisky from Buffalo to Pittsburgh — with many more switches to come.

Staying put are Tampa Bay center Ryan Jensen, a key protector of the now-unretired Tom Brady; Arizona running back James Conner and quarterback Colt McCoy; safeties Devin McCourty with New England and Quandre Diggs with Seattle; kick returner/receiver Braxton Berrios with the Jets; defensive end Emmanuel Ogbah with Miami; linebacker Preston Smith with Green Bay; center Mitch Morse with Buffalo; linebacker Alex Anzalone with Detroit; center Ben Jones and tight end Geoff Swaim with Tennessee; and center Brian Allen and tackle Joseph Noteboom with the Super Bowl champion Los Angeles Rams

"We are excited to have Preston continue his career with the Packers," General Manager Brian Gutekunst said. "Since coming to Green Bay, he has not only contributed with production on the field but has been a great presence in the locker room and a leader for this team."

Set free and able to sign with another team even before Wednesday were Browns receiver Jarvis Landry; Packers linebacker Za'Darius Smith and versatile offensive lineman Billy Turner; Bears nose tackle Eddie Goldman; and Panthers cornerback A.J. Bouye and defensive end Morgan Fox.

Yes, 32 teams are in scramble mode, for a variety of reasons. Some desperately need to get under the \$208.2 million cap, which is up by nearly \$26 million after two pandemic-impacted seasons. The Packers, Saints, Rams, 49ers and Chiefs are among those.

Others are clearing out players with large cap hits to add more spending room or because they plan to bring

in replacements. Such is the case in Cleveland with Amari Cooper about to become the No. 1 wideout, so Landry is gone despite the many positives he brought to the Browns.

"Jarvis' on-field production and fiery competitiveness speaks for itself, but his leadership and team-oriented attitude impacted our culture in a way that will last in time even beyond his release," GM Andrew Berry said. "These decisions are always difficult, but we wish Jarvis well and we look forward to the day when he returns as a storied Browns alumnus."

The biggest scramble, of course, centers on adding players for positions of need. Trubisky in Pittsburgh makes some sense with Ben Roethlisberger retired. Reddick, from the Philly area and a sack force in recent years, should boost a defense in need of exactly what he brings. Miami badly needs a reliable running back and gets one in Edmonds, who would have been a backup to Conner in Arizona.

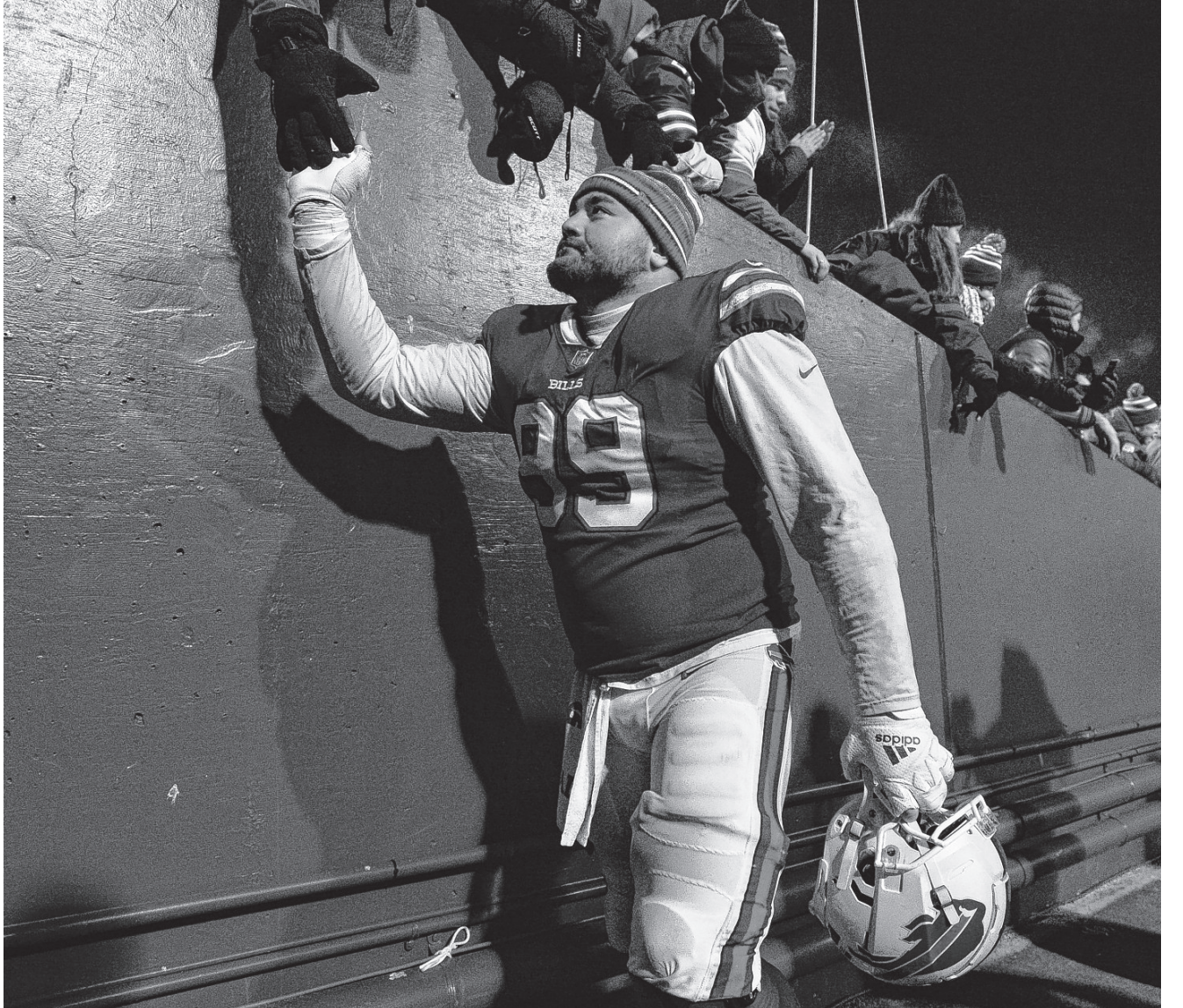

# Ex-Bill Phillips to join Vikings

The Vikings also moved to retain kicker Greg Joseph, a restricted free agent, with a right-of-first refusal tender worth \$2.344 million for next season.

Meanwhile, the Vikings' 19 unrestricted free agents hit the open market Monday during the start of the NFL's negotiating window. Linebacker Anthony Barr, cornerback Patrick Peterson, defensive tackle Sheldon Richardson and tight end Tyler Conklin, among others, are free to negotiate with other teams.

The Vikings expressed interest in retaining some of their free agents, including safety Xavier Woods and Conklin, according to league sources. But Woods found a bigger payday in a three-year agreement with the Panthers on Monday worth up to \$15.75 million, a source said, after he was the NFL's only defender to play every snap last season.

The Vikings' current commitments have them tight against the cap, which could lead to further moves on a top-heavy roster.

A handful of high-priced veterans could be means to that end, whether through

cuts, restructures or trades, including defensive end Danielle Hunter, who has an \$18 million roster bonus due March 20, receiver Adam Thielen and linebacker Eric Kendricks. The Vikings had tried to restructure Pierce's deal, a source said, but couldn't come to an agreement.

In the Vikings' other areas of need, top free agents saw quick paydays on Monday. Coach Kevin O'Connell's former team, the Rams, locked up two offensive linemen with three-year extensions for center Brian Allen and tackle Joseph Noteboom. Two other centers, the Buccaneers' Ryan Jensen and Titans' Ben Jones, also agreed to extensions.

According to reports, 49ers guard Laken Tomlinson can earn up to \$40 million on a three-year deal with the Jets, while the Panthers agreed to terms with former Rams guard Austin Corbett on a three-year deal worth up to nearly \$30 million.

The Jaguars were the biggest spenders out of the gate, led by adding former Commanders guard Brandon Scherff, an All-Pro in 2020, on a three-year deal worth up to \$49.5 million. Jacksonville also reportedly agreed to deals with receiver Christian Kirk, linebacker Foye Oluokun, tight end Evan Engram, receiver Zay Jones and nose tackle Foley Fatukahi.

The Vikings might need an upgrade at right guard or at least add more depth after Mason Cole became their first free agent to agree to terms elsewhere. Cole is expected to sign a three-year, \$15.75 million deal with the Pittsburgh Steelers, according to ESPN, after starting seven games — four at center, three at right guard — for the Vikings last season.

The interior offensive line market still includes Ravens center/guard Bradley Bozeman and Jaguars guard Andrew Norwell.

Two top free-agent cornerbacks, the Patriots' J.C. Jackson and the Buccaneers' Carlton Davis, reportedly agreed to deals worth at least \$15 million per season. Jackson will join the Chargers, while Davis is staying in Tampa Bay. Many experienced corners remain available, including veterans with ties to new Vikings coaches such as the Broncos' Bryce Callahan and Kyle Fuller and the Packers' Kevin King.

Joseph's restricted free agency means he can still field offers from other NFL teams before signing. The Vikings have the right to match another offer. There's no draft pick compensation if another team signs him, unlike first-round (about \$5.5 million) and second-round tenders (about \$4 million).

Joseph made 21 consecutive kicks to end a roller-coaster season, in which the NFL journeyman made game-winning kicks against the Lions and Packers and missed a potential game winner in a close loss at Arizona. He earned his first full-time job on his sixth team in Minnesota, where he beat undrafted rookie Riley Patterson for the job last summer before making 33 of 38 field goals (86.8%) and 36 of 40 extra points (90%).

The rest of the Vikings' internal free agents are cornerback Mackensie Alexander, linebacker Nick Vigil, tackle Rashod Hill, punter Jordan Berry, quarterback Sean Mannion, receivers Chad Beebe and Dede Westbrook, defensive ends Everson Griffen and Tashawn Bower, guard Dakota Dozier, tight ends Luke Stocker and Chris Herndon and running back Wayne Gallman.

Hill, the longtime swing tackle, intends to gauge his value in free agency, according to his agent Brett Tessler, who said a return to Minnesota is "possible." Hill, 30, has started at least one game in each of the past five years — 22 starts overall — including five at left tackle last season.
