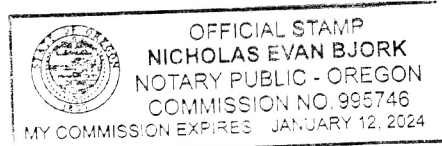

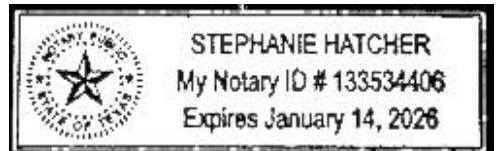

Reynolds nabs 21st BMX X Games medal

VENTURA, Calif. — A lone X Games gold medal leader will have to wait.

With a score of 82.33, popular BMX rider Garrett Reynolds finished in third place on Friday in the X Games California BMX Street event at Ventura County Fairgrounds & Events Center, capturing bronze for his 21st career X Games medal.

But Reynolds fell short of setting the all-time record for X Games gold medals and remains tied with snowboarding legend Shaun White with 15. Reynolds earned a score of 82.33 on his first run before falling on his second and third runs and failing to complete them.

"I try to get one solid run down and then build off of that. Both my second runs I just wound up falling early," Reynolds told USA TODAY Sports. "And it's like, with everyone's runs when you fall early, you're kind of screwed."

Reynolds was in third place entering his final run but didn't feel pressure to make something happen. He said he relates the situation to being in the streets and getting kicked out by a security guard, telling himself, "It's now or never."

Mexico's Kevin Peraza won gold, becoming the first athlete in X Games history to own gold medals in BMX Park, Dirt and Street.

Reynolds tied White last year after the BMX Street event at X Games 2022.

The 32-year-old New Jersey native had the chance to make history two months ago at X Games Japan, but he placed third.

And entering the competition, fans were prepared for the possibility of Reynolds bouncing back. A premed video was shown right before his first run.

The anticipation and buzz from the crowd followed Reynolds each time he prepared for his run — the announcer often emphasizing the history fans were

potentially going to see.

The storyline can be exhausting for Reynolds and it's one he expressed he'd prefer to end.

"I would like to put it to sleep because I feel like it's quite stressful for me just hearing it. Like 'this guy's got to win one more,'" Reynolds said. "It'd be cool to like not hear it and just be like kind of back to how it used to be."

"But, I don't know. In its own right, it's cool that I can make a storyline for the contest and something to look forward to) for next time."

Reynolds made his X Games debut in 2007 as a 17-year-old competing in the BMX Park event. He competed in his first BMX Street event the year after, winning gold and beginning an impressive podium streak that continued Friday — Reynolds has never finished lower than third in the event.

From 2008 to 2017, Reynolds won a gold medal in each X Games BMX Street competition. He placed second and third in 2018's X Games Minneapolis and Sydney, respectively, before reclaiming gold in X Games Minneapolis 2019.

Young skateboarders shine at X Games California

VENTURA, Calif. — While watching the Pacifico Women's Skateboard Vert at X Games California 2023 on Saturday, the PA announcer cracked a joke. He said the combined age of the top three was still younger than he was. The crowd laughed.

There's truth to every joke and there definitely is one in this instance. The top three rounded out with 13-year-old Arisa Trew earning gold, 10-year-old Reese Nelson earning silver and 16-year-old Asahi Kaihara earning bronze.

Nelson became the youngest medalist ever in X Games history.

Trew became the youngest double gold medalist in X Games history after winning skateboard park on Sunday, breaking a 20-year record held by Shaun White. She's already the youngest to land a 720 in the X Games, which she did again to earn gold on Saturday.

The X Games have been dominated by skaters barely old enough to be in junior high school, let alone spinning three times in the air with a skateboard.

At X Games Chiba in May, 31% of the field was in their teens, the highest percentage in X Games history. The women's skate park run included an average age of 17 years old, an event that was won by 14-year-old Cocona Hiraki.

This month's X Games California has been no different with 30 preteens and teens, which made up 22% of the entire field.

In the women's skateboard street, no one on the podium was older than 16, including gold medal winner and 13-year-old Chloe Covell. The average age for female skaters was 17 years, 6 months. The men's reached 26 years, 7 months, slightly skewed by 55-year-old Tony Hawk.

The average age of the Women's Skateboarding Vert podium was 13 years, 6 months, the youngest in X Games history.

A combined age of 39 years old on that podium means that group is just one year older than LeBron James, six years younger than Tom Brady and 16 years younger than Hawk, the man who

is likely responsible for the influx of young skaters.

"Tony inspired everybody, and personally he inspired me so, so much. When he landed 900, I just said, oh, I wanna do that," 14-year-old Gui Khury told USA TODAY Sports.

Khury did exactly that on Friday, landing a 900 during the men's skateboard vert. That's slightly less head spinning than Khury's best. Two years ago, he did the first 1080 in X Games history as a 12-year-old during the men's skateboard vert best trick to become the youngest gold medalist in X Games history.

He joins 14-year-old Sky Brown and 15-year-old Rayssa Leal as some of the best young skaters.

Brown is already an Olympic gold medalist and back-to-back X Games gold medalist in women's skateboard park. Leal won every street league skateboarding competition last year and gold at X Games Chiba. Khury reclaimed gold in the skateboard vert best trick event on Sunday.

"I think it's really cool to see a lot of younger skaters, especially Rayssa and Sky Brown," Khury said. "They're really good now and practically winning all contests. And it's really cool just to see the new generation coming around."

Skateboarding being a youthful sport is nothing new though, according to Hawk, who went pro at 14 years old. Popular skateboarder Nyjah Huston made his X Games debut as an 11-year-old. Seven-time X Games medalist Ryan Sheckler won his first X Games gold at 13.

However, there's a key difference now compared to when Hawk and others started out.

"I think the change now is that kids get into it earlier and they have support and also you can do it into your 50s and that was not the case when I was involved," Hawk said. "So now it's such a diverse age group and for backgrounds, it's very inclusive. I feel like skateboarding is finally come of age."

There's a certain community that's been established between the youngest

skaters in the field too.

After each skater's run during the women's skateboard vert event, congratulations were always spread around. Trew's final run earned her a gold medal and prompted a group of skaters to hound her once her score was announced.

"I think it's just because we all have something in common because we all skate and we're all friends, so it's just easy to hang around each other and have fun," said Trew during the X Games broadcast on Sunday.

Even though Trew took home gold in the vert, it was impossible to ignore the emergence of Nelson, a 10-year-old from Canada.

She sat in the driver's seat for a gold medal with a score of 88.00 until Trew's final run earned her a score of 90.33. Nelson came out fearless, flying across the vert course and leaving fans enamored by her talent.

She's worked closely with Hawk — the two skating together regularly — and nearly stole the show on Saturday with her twists and turns high up in the air. Though some viewers may be shocked to see a 10-year-old competing at the X Games, Hawk emphasized he would have been surprised if Nelson wasn't here.

"She is truly phenomenal, way skilled beyond her years," Hawk said. "And the thing that I'm impressed about her most is her trick selection, because she goes to some of the most difficult moves without using the steppingstones to get to those moves. And she figures it out. And that is extremely rare."

Nelson emergence is simply in line with the way skateboarding has always been.

She hopes she'll inspire other young skaters to start skating and trying to compete too. Being one of the youngest skaters doesn't change much for her to since everyone is typically around the same group.

"My friends are all of these people," Nelson said.

Judging by the way the sport is moving, it won't be a surprise if Nelson has more young skaters and friends joining her soon.
