COLLEGE FOOTBALL WEEK 6 OVERREACTIONS

Upsets swing playoff, awards pendulum

The random nature of sports makes it impossible to foresee every game's outcome.

A lot of well-lit buildings in the desert stand as testimony to this reality.

College football is especially prone to such randomness. Most of the time analysts might feel like they have a handle on which team might prevail in a head-to-head encounter.

An overreaction? Perhaps, but that's what we're here for in this space.

The top overreactions from Week 6, one of the most chaotic in recent memory.

The Big Ten will get more playoff spots than the SEC

As the perceived top-tier teams of the SEC began playing each other, some of them taking losses was inevitable. Now that several of those expected contenders have taken losses at the hands of lower-echelon conference members, it's fair to question how many losses can be absorbed to earn at-large consideration in the newly expanded 12-team playoff.

As a result, it is the Big Ten that now has three teams ranked in the top five of the US LBM Coaches Poll. That trio has thus far avoided such losses to mid-tier squads.

But can they continue to do so, and

will the crowded SEC manage to sort itself out?

It's impossible to know at this point, but it will certainly make for an interesting next two months.

Jalen Milroe just lost the Heisman

Let's be clear. Alabama's historic loss at Vanderbilt was not entirely quarterback Jalen Milroe's fault. Yes, his pick-six put the Crimson Tide in an early hole. And his fumble in the fourth quarter was costly. But his defense's inability to get off the field severely limited his opportunities, and as such every mistake was magnified.

His heroics of a week earlier in the victory against Georgia still happened,

and just as the award isn't won with a single performance, neither is it lost. That said, his lead in the race has been reduced. He'll have plenty of other high-profile games.

The ACC replay booth is in the tank for Miami

It's fairly indisputable that the ACC's best chance of landing two teams in the College Football Playoff is for Miami and Clemson to win out and face each other in the league finale. This has led to much, shall we say, questioning of motives on the internet over the last couple of weeks as the Hurricanes benefited from controversial replay decisions in consecutive weeks.

We don't normally like to give oxygen to conspiracy theories, and the idea that the league office would go to bat for a program that has caused it more than its share of headaches over the years by playing fast and loose with NCAA rules seems far-fetched. Then again, one can understand how the events of the last eight days might make folks wonder.

The reversal of the last-second Hail Mary touchdown that preserved the Hurricanes' win against Virginia Tech might indeed have been the correct call, or at least have negated a wrong one made on the field.

Saturday's decision not to assess a targeting foul for a hit on Cal quarterback Fernando Mendoza seems significantly harder to justify.

Imperfect officiating has been part of

the sport since time immemorial, and the implementation of replay review can't eliminate that aspect entirely. Miami probably shouldn't count on such disputed outcomes to continue going its way, despite public perception of alleged favoritism.

Vanderbilt going bowling in 2024

Vandy's rare triumph against a Top 5 opponent has fans of the SEC's perennial gridiron doormat dreaming of even bigger things. The next box for the Commodores to check will be qualifying for a bowl game, something that hasn't happened since 2018 and has occurred only nine times in the program's history.

It could happen, but even with the win against the Crimson Tide in the bank it isn't a guarantee. For one thing, that Week 3 loss to Georgia State can't be undone. That result as well as the overtime heartbreaker to Missouri leaves the Commodores in need of three more wins. One of those should come in a couple of weeks in their final non-conference contest against Ball State, so two more W's in conference play must be found. This week's date with Kentucky and a Nov. 2 meeting with Auburn are winnable, but both are on the road, making them 50-50 propositions. There's also a home date with an up-and-down South Carolina squad. But if the Commodores can't win two of those, they'll have to spring another upset against Texas, LSU or Tennessee. Can they do it? Sure. Will they? Stay tuned.

NCAA RE-RANK 1-134

Texas edges Ohio State at top

With Alabama out of the picture after a stunning loss to Vanderbilt, Texas fends off Ohio State and takes over as the new No. 1 in the USA TODAY Sports Re-Rank 1-134.

That makes three teams at No. 1 in three weeks. Georgia led the re-rank from the preseason until the loss to the Crimson Tide.

The Longhorns had some competition for the top spot from the Buckeyes, who looked very good in the second half of Saturday's 35-7 win against Iowa. But Texas has the edge in strength of schedule, mostly due to a win at Michigan in Week 2.

Overall, the top part of the re-rank has been shaken up by Saturday's run of upsets. Alabama is down to No. 9 after falling to the Commodores. Tennessee is down four spots to No. 8 after losing to Arkansas. Missouri drops to No. 24 after getting blown out by Texas A&M, and the Wolverines land at No. 25 after losing at Washington.

Some of the big gainers in the Power Four include No. 18 Indiana, No. 20 SMU,

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Liberty stars put on WNBA show for college coaches

NEW YORK — Breanna Stewart needed to rant.

“It’s about time,” the New York Liberty forward said just minutes after leading her team to an 80-66 win over the Minnesota Lynx on Sunday in Game 2 of the WNBA Finals, a victory in which she tallied 21 points, eight rebounds and a career-high seven steals.

She wasn’t referring to the much-needed win, a particular officiating call or the fact that New York set an attendance record with 18,046 fans.

No, she was calling out her college coach, Geno Aureimma, the 11-time national champion widely considered the greatest of all time.

“I text him and was like, you know what, it’s about time that you come to my game,” Stewart said as the press room chuckled. She shook her head in mock disgust. “I’ve been here for two years and he hasn’t come down! What are you doing?”

After the game, holding her 3-year-old daughter Ruby at center court, Stewart told ESPN reporter Holly Rowe that she felt the need to put on a good show for Aureimma, since he decided to show his face at the Barclays Center.

Also sitting courtside for Game 2: C. Vivian Stringer, the first coach to lead three different teams to the NCAA women’s basketball Final Four. She did that with Rutgers most recently in 2007 — and four years later, Betnijah Laney-Hamilton starred for Stringer and the Scarlet Knights. (She retired in 2022.)

After she scored a season-high-tying 20 points, Laney-Hamilton smiled and

said anytime her college coach is in the building, she wants to make her proud.

Laney-Hamilton’s performance, as she continues to battle a right knee injury, got Stringer on her feet a couple of times, and who could blame her for being so excited — especially when Laney-Hamilton started the game 4-for-4 from the field, helping the Liberty build as much as a 17-point lead.

“I was happy to be able to play well in front of her,” said Laney-Hamilton, who scored in double figures for the first time since Sept. 22 — New York’s first playoff game of 2024. She also recorded two as-

sists and a steal.

“It gives me a little bit of momentum as we continue to go through the series,” she said. “I’ve been struggling physically, mentally, as I’ve been going through everything, so to see a glimpse of what I’m capable of, it felt really good.”

So, which college coaches of other Liberty players are coming to Minnesota for Games 3 and 4?

Sabrina Ionescu was quick to answer that in the press conference, saying that her college coach, Oregon’s Kelly Graves, would be in the Target Center on Wednesday. That means the Liberty can probably expect a big game from Ionescu and guard Courtney Vandersloot, who played for Graves at Gonzaga.

“They are all welcome,” New York coach Sandy Brondello said, laughing.

Sunday was a vintage Stewart performance, and in truth, she didn’t need her college coach on the sideline to hype her up.

Stewart is a three-time Olympian and two-time MVP for a reason. After a fourth-quarter (and overtime) fiasco in Game 1 — which included a missed Stewart free throw at the end of regulation that would have won it — Stewart said, “the moment the game ended Thursday night, I was looking forward to Sunday.”

She played like it, too. Stewart had two huge sequences in the second half.

At the end of the third quarter she drew back-to-back fouls on Liberty possessions, hit two free throws on the second, denied a Lynx shot on the other end and then hit a runner, giving New York a 61-53 lead with 55.8 seconds to go and halting any momentum Minnesota had.

Her other stretch might have been even more impressive.

With the Liberty clinging to a two-point lead, 66-64, with 5:36 left, Stewart recorded back-to-back steals on Minnesota possessions, refusing to let the Lynx tie or take the lead. New York finished the game on a 12-0 run over the final 3:21, which included a timely corner 3 from Laney-Hamilton and an offensive tip-in by Stewart.

Given Laney-Hamilton’s season, her performance might have been even more impressive than Stewart’s. Certainly it was grittier.

In July, just before the month-long Olympic break, Laney-Hamilton had minor surgery on her knee, returning to the Liberty in late July. She’s been bugged by it all season and in obvious pain for stretches. Brondello said earlier in the series that even after surgery Laney-Hamilton is not 100%.

Sunday, she praised her toughness. “She was digging deep,” Brondello said, “and that’s what we needed.”

Stewart agreed, saying, “I think what B brings is this grit, this toughness ... all of us know, she’s giving us whatever she’s got.”

“We know she can do this and happy to see her get into a good rhythm with everything that’s been up and down this season and know that she’s a big factor in everything we do.”

Laney-Hamilton didn’t want to assign herself a percentage of health and declined to get into specifics of treatment, saying only that the Liberty have been “doing a little bit of everything to try to get me feeling good.”

Clearly, it’s working. But to be safe, they should probably invite Stringer — and Aureimma — on the charter to Minneapolis, too.

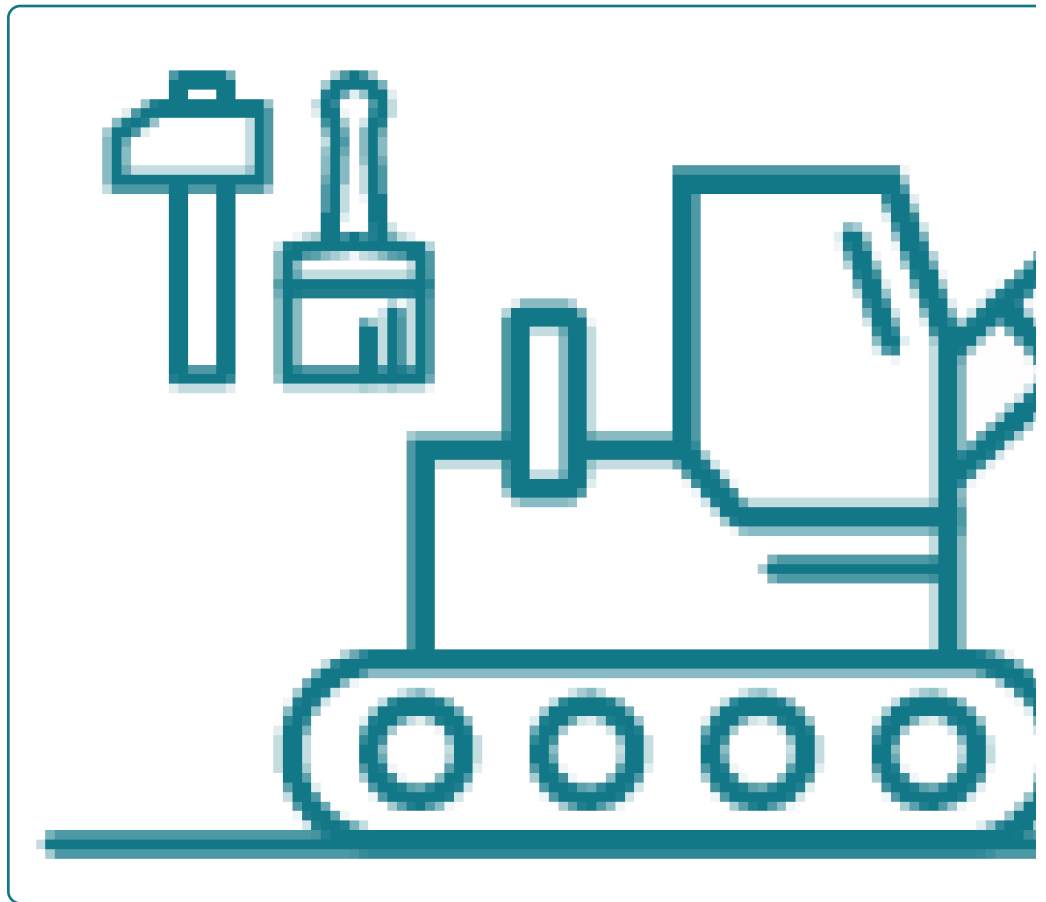

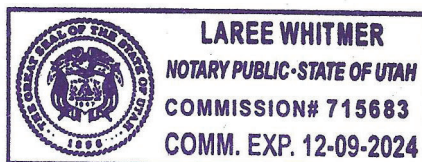

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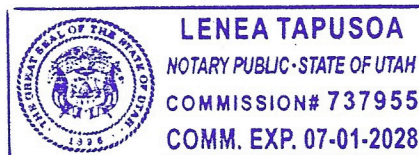
