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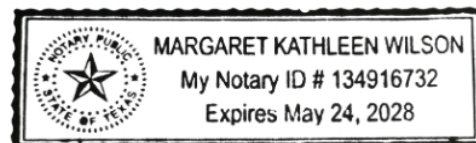

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# Carter’s Olympic boycott was wrong call

While history has softened the harsh view of Jimmy Carter’s presidency, there is one part of his legacy that looks worse as the years pass.

Carter, who died Sunday in Plains, Georgia, at the age of 100, called to boycott the 1980 Olympics because of the Soviet Union’s invasion of Afghanistan, and the pressure he exerted on the U.S. Olympic Committee to comply was wrong and naïve. It accomplished nothing other than to further entrench the antagonism between the United States and the Soviet Union, and inserted politics where it didn’t belong.

Worse, it punished hundreds of athletes, robbing them of the moment and opportunity for which they had trained and sacrificed.

Not just American athletes, either. Other countries joined the United States in boycotting the Summer Games in Moscow, including Canada and Japan, and the Soviet Union and much of the Eastern bloc retaliated four years later in Los Angeles.

Carter raised the possibility of a boycott in January 1980, a month after the Soviet Union invaded Afghanistan, hoping the embarrassment of the world staying home from the Summer Games would convince the communist powerhouse to leave Afghanistan. After the Soviets ignored a February deadline, Carter officially announced the boycott March 21, 1980.

But it is the USOC, not the White House, that sends teams to the Olympics.

In an April speech to USOC leaders, Vice President Walter Mondale painted the boycott as a moral imperative, saying “no less than the future security of the civilized world” was at stake in Afghanistan. He likened the Soviet invasion to Hitler’s Nazi Germany and said

the United States could not make the same mistake it had in 1936, when Jesse Owens led an American team to the Berlin Games.

“As Joseph Goebbels boasted on the eve of the Olympics, the Reich expected the Games ‘to turn the trick and create a friendly world attitude toward Nazi political, economic, and racial aims.’ It worked,” Mondale told the USOC. “... Neither Jesse’s achievements in Berlin nor any words spoken at the Games prevented the Reich from exploiting the Olympics toward their own brutal ends.”

A few hours after Mondale’s speech, the USOC agreed to Carter’s demand and said it would not send a team to Moscow.

While athletes were hailed as patriots and praised for their sacrifice, that was little consolation for the harsh reality of Olympic sports.

With the Games held once every four years, most athletes get only one shot when they’re in their prime. Four years

earlier and they’re probably too young. Four years later and they’re probably too old.

The boycott meant hundreds of athletes missed out on the opportunity to be recognized by the entire world as the best in the sports to which they’d devoted their entire lives. Given this was still in the days before professionals could compete in the Olympics, those athletes who would have won medals lost out on post-Games economic opportunities, including lucrative speaking engagements for which they’d still be in demand long after their days as an athlete had ended.

Take Bill Rodgers, arguably one of the greatest distance runners ever.

Rodgers was 40th in the marathon at the 1976 Olympics in Montreal. But beginning with the New York Marathon later that year, he won 15 of his next 19 races at the 26.2-mile distance, including Boston in 1978, 1979 and 1980.

He set an American record at Boston in 1979, and Track & Field News ranked

him No. 1 in the marathon for a third time that year. Had the United States gone to Moscow, he would have been a favorite to join Frank Shorter (1972), John Hayes (1908) and Thomas Hicks (1904) as the only U.S. men to win the Olympic marathon, a feat that would have made him a commercial superstar.

But the United States didn’t go to Moscow. And by the time the Los Angeles Games arrived, Rodgers’ career was in decline. He finished eighth at the 1984 Olympic trials and didn’t even make the U.S. team for LA.

“We’re simply a tool, an implement,” Rodgers told The Washington Post at the time. “No one cares at all, until we can be used for their purposes. Then they can use it.”

At least Rodgers could still call himself an Olympian, having competed in Montreal. But there were other athletes for whom Moscow was their only chance. They remain in a weird sort of athletic purgatory, Olympians without an Olympics.

“I feel like a doctor who knows the specialty, but I don’t have that M.D.,” wrestler Lee Kemp, who would have been the heavy favorite for gold at 74 kilograms in Moscow after winning the world title in 1978 and 1979, told the New Orleans Times-Picayune in 2010.

Kemp retired after finishing second at the 1984 Olympic trials.

Had the boycott accomplished what Carter hoped, maybe athletes could have taken some comfort in knowing their sacrifice had brought about change. But many of the United States’ closest allies – Britain and France among them – refused to join the boycott. The politics Carter hoped to keep out of the Olympics are now endemic to the Games.

And not until February 1989, almost a decade later, would the Soviet Union leave Afghanistan.

“There was not one positive,” Kemp told the Times-Picayune. “Not one.”

Forty-four years later, it’s even more apparent Carter made the wrong decision.

# NASCAR fandom collided with peace talks

Jimmy Carter was a fan of NASCAR, but the possibility of peace in the Middle East got in the way when several drivers came to the White House for ham and cornbread in 1978.

Carter, the 39th president of the United States, died Sunday in Plains, Georgia. He was 100.

While governor of Georgia in the 1970s, Carter attended races at Atlanta Motor Speedway and hosted racers at the governor’s mansion.

In the previous decade, he had worked speedway events as a ticket vendor.

Upon running for president in 1976, he pledged to bring NASCAR to the White House for dinner if elected.

But when the dinner bell eventually rang, in the summer of 1978, Carter was at the Camp David presidential retreat, where he was working on a breakthrough peace accord with Israeli Prime Minister Menachem Begin and Egyptian President Anwar Sadat.

In the president’s absence, first lady Rosalynn Carter hosted the NASCAR contingent, which included many drivers, including Hall of Famers Cale Yarborough, David Pearson and Benny Parsons, as well as NASCAR leaders Bill France Jr. and Sr.

The night was capped off with a Willie Nelson concert. And no, this wasn’t Willie’s high-rollin’ White House visit – it wasn’t until two years later that Nelson famously joined Carter’s son Chip

atop the White House roof and smoked weed. Carter and his son confirmed the widely shared rumor in “Jimmy Carter: Rock & Roll President,” a documentary released in 2020.

After serving a single term in the White House, Carter, the onetime pea-

nut farmer and Navy submariner, became among the most durable figures in modern American politics.

Evicted from the White House at age 56, he would hold the status of former president longer than anyone in American history, and in 2019 he surpassed

the late George H. W. Bush as the nation’s oldest living ex-president.

He was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize in 2002, 22 years after he had left the White House.

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TGL WHAT TO KNOW

League matches

Each TGL match consists of two sessions. The first session is a nine-hole, 3-on-3 alternate-shot format known as “triples.” In the second session, golfers compete in singles, going head-to-head over six holes, with each playing two holes. A shot clock set to 40 seconds adds to the pressure, as any violation incurs a one-stroke penalty. Each hole is worth one point. If the teams are tied at the end of regulation, the match will proceed to overtime. During OT, players compete head-to-head, and the team that lands its shot closest to the pin will be declared the winner.

# Matsuyama closed in style

KAPALUA, Hawaii – After birdieing half the holes at Kapalua Resort’s Plantation Course on Saturday along with an eagle for an 11-under-par 62, Hideki Matsuyama never cracked a smile. The 32-year-old Japanese star also declined to speak separately to the Japanese media, a dedicated crew that follows his every shot and hangs on his every word, for the second straight day. And this was – we repeat – after a bogey-free 62 that set a tournament 54-hole scoring mark and equaled the PGA Tour record too.

“I mean, he was matching me (Saturday) shot for shot, and I felt like I was playing lights out, right?” said Collin Morikawa, who had matched Matsuyama shot for shot and didn’t bother to hit another ball at the range. “Like, yes, you could leave some shots out there, but you shoot 11-under on any golf course, you’re going to be happy, right?”

Matsuyama, however, is his own toughest critic and he hightailed it to the range to iron out the flaws he perceived in his game.

What could he possibly need to do at the range is a head-scratcher, but Matsuyama said he needed to fix his driver and we’ll take his word because it worked. The grind never ends, and very few can match Matsuyama’s grit and determination to scrape every ounce of brilliance out of his game.

All the hard work paid off on Sunday when Matsuyama took dead aim at the par-4 fourth hole and two-hopped a wedge from 107 yards into the hole for an eagle.

The mercurial Matsuyama, who has a well-earned reputation for hanging his head or dropping a hand off his club in disgust, only for the shot in question to be a thing of beauty, stared down his approach at the fourth and knocked knuckles with his caddie when it dropped. He closed in 8-under 65 to win The Sentry, the season-opening tournament on the PGA Tour by three shots over Morikawa, and notch his third victory in a signature event in the last 10 months.

Morikawa, who shot a final-round 67 despite his putter cooling off, reached the par-5 15th in two and made birdie to trim his deficit to two but once Matsuyama wedged inside 4 feet at 16 to stretch the lead to three, Morikawa sensed that he wasn’t going to catch Matsuyama. He settled for his second runner-up at The Sentry in three years.

“Excuse my language, but 35-under

par is, that’s low,” said Morikawa, dropping an F-bomb for emphasis. “Today he just never let up.”

Wearing his Sunday yellow, the color of his university in Japan, Matsuyama closed in style with an 8-foot birdie putt to set the all-time 72-hole scoring record in relation to par with a total of 35-under 257.

“That last putt, it felt like if I make it, then it’s going to be the record, so I’m so happy that it went in,” Matsuyama said.

Matsuyama previously won the Sony Open in Hawaii in 2022, and his Sentry title made him the seventh player to win the Hawaiian Slam.

To earn the 11th PGA Tour victory of his career, Matsuyama’s game fired on all cylinders. He ranked first in stroke gained: tee to green, second in SG: approach the green, and third in scrambling and SG: putting. Matsuyama, who loves to tinker with putters and said he traveled to Maui with four different options, inserted a Scotty Cameron 009M CS prototype putter that he’d seen another player use and received shortly after Christmas into the bag for the first time this week.

“I thought, ‘Oh, this looks good,’ so I had them make one,” he explained of the putter change on Thursday.

His putter delivered on Sunday. After Morikawa hit a beauty to 10 feet at the par-3 11th green, Matsuyama poured in a 31-foot birdie putt, and one hole later he rolled in a 21-foot birdie putt to build his lead to four. He even waved to the crowd in delight.

“When the heat is on, he’s nails,” said Golf Channel’s Brandel Chamblee.

And when the final putt dropped at 18 to break Cameron Smith’s 72-hole scoring record from the 2022 Sentry, Matsuyama’s caddie Shoto Hayafuji celebrated the special week as only he can.

Hayafuji, who famously took his hat off and bowed after placing the flagstick back in the hole at 18 when Matsuyama won the 2021 Masters, showed more emotion this time, bumping chests with Mikito Kiromiya, Matsuyama’s golf coach, before lifting him into his arms and then leaping into the arms of Yuyu Suzuki, another member of Matsuyama’s support team. Matsuyama was mid-interview as this was happening but the corners of his mouth turned upward.

At last, he had reason to smile.

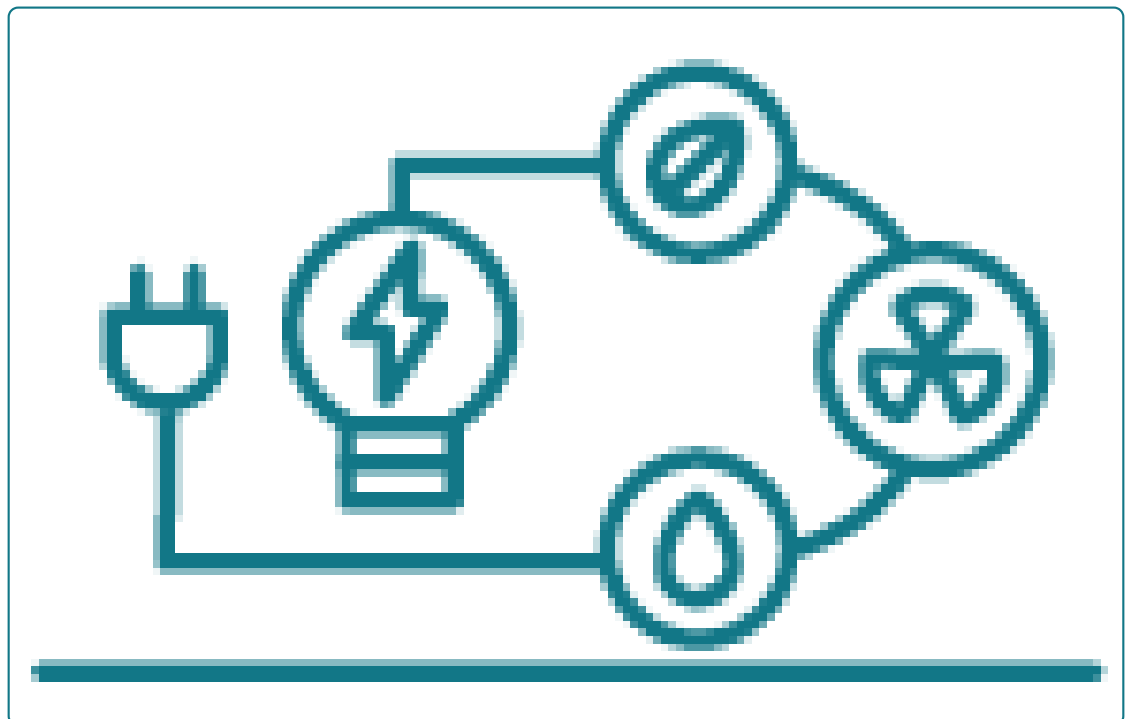
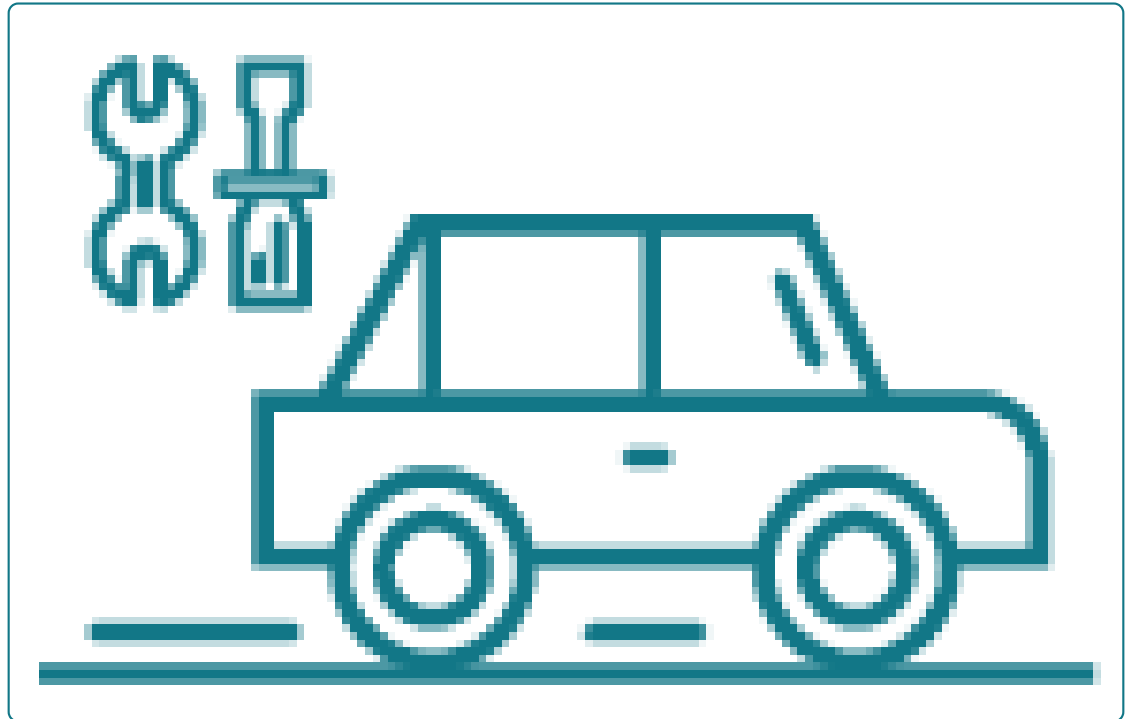

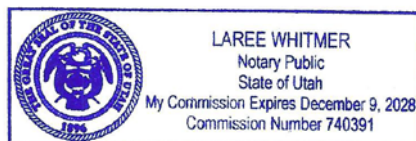
