Matsuyama closed in style

KAPALUA, Hawaii - After birdieing half the holes at Kapalua Resort's Plantation Course on Saturday along with an eagle for an 11-under-par 62, Hideki Matsuyama never cracked a smile. The 32year-old Japanese star also declined to speak separately to the Japanese media, a dedicated crew that follows his every shot and hangs on his every word, for the second straight day. And this was - we repeat - after a bogey-free 62 that set a tournament 54-hole scoring mark and equaled the PGA Tour record too.

"I mean, he was matching me (Saturday) shot for shot, and I felt like I was playing lights out, right?" said Collin Morikawa, who had matched Matsuyama shot for shot and didn't bother to hit another ball at the range. "Like, yes, you could leave some shots out there, but you shoot 11-under on any golf course, you're going to be happy, right?"

Matsuyama, however, is his own toughest critic and he hightailed it to the range to iron out the flaws he perceived in his game.

What could he possibly need to do at the range is a head-scratcher, but Matsuyama said he needed to fix his driver and we'll take his word because it worked. The grind never ends, and very few can match Matsuyama's grit and determination to scrape every ounce of brilliance out of his game.

All the hard work paid off on Sunday when Matsuyama took dead aim at the par-4 fourth hole and two-hopped a wedge from 107 yards into the hole for an eagle.

The mercurial Matsuyama, who has a well-earned reputation for hanging his head or dropping a hand off his club in disgust, only for the shot in question to be a thing of beauty, stared down his approach at the fourth and knocked knuckles with his caddie when it dropped. He closed in 8-under 65 to win The Sentry, the season-opening tournament on the PGA Tour by three shots over Morikawa, and notch his third victory in a signature event in the last 10 months.

Morikawa, who shot a final-round 67 despite his putter cooling off, reached the par-515th in two and made birdie to trim his deficit to two but once Matsuyama wedged inside 4 feet at 16 to stretch the lead to three, Morikawa sensed that he wasn't going to catch Matsuyama. He settled for his second runner-up at The Sentry in three years.

"Excuse my language, but 35-under

par is, that's low," said Morikawa, dropping an F-bomb for emphasis. "Today he just never let up."

Wearing his Sunday yellow, the color of his university in Japan, Matsuyama closed in style with an 8-foot birdie putt to set the all-time 72-hole scoring record in relation to par with a total of 35-under 257.

"That last putt, it felt like if I make it, then it's going to be the record, so I'm so happy that it went in," Matsuyama said.

Matsuyama previously won the Sony Open in Hawaii in 2022, and his Sentry title made him the seventh player to win the Hawaiian Slam.

To earn the 11th PGA Tour victory of his career, Matsuyama's game fired on all cylinders. He ranked first in stroke gained: tee to green, second in SG: approach the green, and third in scrambling and SG: putting. Matsuyama, who loves to tinker with putters and said he traveled to Maui with four different options, inserted a Scotty Cameron 009M CS prototype putter that he'd seen another player use and received shortly after Christmas into the bag for the first time this week.

"I thought, 'Oh, this looks good,' so I

had them make one," he explained of the putter change on Thursday.

His putter delivered on Sunday. After Morikawa hit a beauty to 10 feet at the par-311th green, Matsuyama poured in a 31-foot birdie putt, and one hole later he rolled in a 21-foot birdie putt to build his lead to four. He even waved to the crowd in delight.

'When the heat is on, he's nails," said Golf Channel's Brandel Chamblee.

And when the final putt dropped at 18 to break Cameron Smith's 72-hole scoring record from the 2022 Sentry, Matsuyama's caddie Shoto Hayafuji celebrated the special week as only he can.

Hayafuji, who famously took his hat off and bowed after placing the flagstick back in the hole at 18 when Matsuyama won the 2021 Masters, showed more emotion this time, bumping chests with Mikito Kiromiya, Matsuyama's golf coach, before lifting him into his arms and then leaping into the arms of Yuyu Suzaki, another member of Matsuyama's support team. Matsuyama was mid-interview as this was happening but the corners of his mouth turned upward.

At last, he had reason to smile.

Vrabel's success could hinge on one factor

Now comes the real intrigue. Yes, Mike Vrabel is back in Foxborough. As expected.

A week after Jerod Mayo was fired just minutes after completing his oneand-done season as Bill Belichick's successor, the New England Patriots made it official on Sunday and named Vrabel as the new coach.

So much for a long, exhaustive search. There was no forest of trees to shake. No bevy of bushes to beat. No search firms, no second interviews, no need to check more references.

Bob Kraft, the charismatic Patriots owner, got his man. And everybody knew this was coming. Even though Vrabel interviewed with the Chicago Bears and New York Jets, and the Las Vegas Raiders seemed like a potential dark horse because of his pal Tom Brady's fingerprints, it always seemed like a matter of when, not if, he would return.

It's also no wonder that Aaron Glenn, the hot Detroit Lions coordinator, turned down New England's request for an interview/intel collection session.

Vrabel was introduced as Patriots coach at noon ET on Monday at the same plaza where he was inducted into the Patriots Hall of Fame in 2023, and the expectations are grand after backto-back 13-loss seasons. So is the symmetry. A member of three of the franchise's six Super Bowl champion units, the former linebacker comes back as an accomplished coach - he guided the Tennessee Titans to three playoff berths in six seasons – with presumably all the ingredients to make it work.

No doubt, Kraft's sentiments are something like: Come fix this!

The intrigue, however, will be revealed with the power structure. To get Vrabel, I'm guessing that he gets a lot more personnel clout than Mayo (a firsttime coach and former Patriots linebacker, too) worked with.

After all, Vrabel was in his position with the Titans long enough, and with a

degree of success, to know what the alignment needs to be between the personnel and coaching wings. While it's a major plus that he inherits a promising young quarterback in Drake Maye, how Vrabel meshes with the existing (and/or altered) personnel department looms as a huge component to his chances for success.

Take it from Tedy Bruschi, the former teammate and close friend of Vrabel's. During ESPN's "Sunday NFL Countdown," Bruschi dropped some serious knowledge about the dynamics of the changeover from Mayo to Vrabel.

"When they hired Jerod, at the press conference a big word that was used was 'collaboration,' " Bruschi, the star analyst, said on the pregame studio show. "Everybody's input and all that stuff. Well, I don't know how much it is that anymore. And I think that's a good thing."

The Patriots don't have a general manager and haven't had anyone carry that title during Kraft's ownership reign. Belichick, though, was viewed as essentially his own de facto GM, given his autonomy in running the football operation – a generation after Bill Parcells' differences with Kraft included his desire to "shop for the groceries."

After Belichick's departure, Eliot Wolf was promoted to executive vice president of personnel from scouting director, with the power of having the final say on personnel moves. He's flanked by senior personnel executive Alonzo Highsmith, who joined the Patriots last year.

The bulk of the personnel staff, however, are holdovers from the Belichick era – which is panned for the results in the latter years that left the Patriots with a depleted talent base.

Key question: Will Vrabel have the final say on personnel?

"In my opinion," Bruschi added on ESPN, "there are some people in the front office that need to be told, 'You don't know what you're doing and you need to take a step back.'

"Vrabel isn't going to joke around. Vrabel is going to tighten the screws."

Which is exactly why Vrabel is such a good hire. Sorry, Mayo.

The process that the Patriots took to get here, though, not so good.

Start with the hiring of Mayo last year. Kraft chose Mayo as Belichick's successor in 2023, writing a clause into his contract that assured as much. Kraft reasoned that with other teams showing interest in the linebacker coach, he

wanted to lock him up long term.

Yet that ultimately prevented the Patriots from conducting a thorough search to replace Belichick. Then Mayo was ultimately undermined because of the weak commitment to stick with him, knowing that it would take a rebuilding job, given the holes in talent.

Here's to hoping that Mayo, a victim of circumstance with the Patriots, eventually gets another shot at becoming a head coach. Also, another example of a pattern where Black coaches are held to a tougher standard than white coaches - since the Rooney Rule was instituted in 2003, nearly 31% of minority coaches were one-and-done, while less than 10% of white coaches during that span were fired after one season or less -Mayo certainly didn't get the patience or support that Vrabel's successor, Brian Callahan, has received from the Titans after finishing 3-14 in his first season.

Of course, Kraft - who could have pursued Vrabel last year if he didn't already have an agreement with Mayo opted out of his rookie coach because of the chance to lure one of the most coveted candidates on the market.

It should provide a lesson for any and all team owners: Be very careful in determining your next head coach. Conditions change. The market changes.

With the Patriots, the path to Vrabel also comes with the slew of questions about their quick compliance with the Rooney Rule. Last Tuesday, two days after Mayo was fired, they conducted two former coordinators, Pep Hamilton and Byron Leftwich, who haven't coached in the NFL since 2022. Were they legitimate candidates?

Perhaps Hamilton and Leftwich have aligned themselves as serious options to become coordinator or assume some other role on Vrabel's staff. We'll see. There's also speculation that Josh McDaniels, the former Patriots coordinator who bombed in head coaching shots with the Denver Broncos and the Raiders, could return to Foxborough.

In any event, in finalizing the multiyear deal with Vrabel on wild-card weekend, the Patriots achieved something during the playoffs that, since Brady left, is no longer the norm.

They scored a big victory.

Commanders' success sweeter without Snyder

when he was a kid and he'd go to games with his dad. Now that the Commanders are finally enjoying success, when they're no longer among the NFL's pariahs and pathetics, Snyder has no claim to it.

The Commanders are somebody

into allegations of sexual misconduct and financial improprieties against him. This is not to be confused with the \$10 million fine the Commanders had to pay after a previous investigation found a toxic and misogynistic culture permeating the team.

There is something incredibly satisfying about watching the Washington Commanders' resurgence and knowing that, somewhere, it's got to be driving Dan Snyder nuts.

For almost a quarter of a century, that miserable, misogynistic and mean-spirited man owned one of the NFL's crown jewels, and for almost that entire time the team was as awful as he was. Six playoff appearances in 24 years, and only one postseason win this century. Just two seasons with double-digit wins. Scandal after scandal after scandal after scandal.

Snyder finally sold the team in the summer of 2023 and, lo and behold! Two seasons later, the Snyder-less Commanders are back in the playoffs. With the fourth-best record in the NFC, no less.

'Thank you guys for everything," current Commanders owner Josh Harris told his team after it clinched a playoff berth. "Playoffs!"

Having a winning team in Washington is good for the NFL, which has seen big ratings for Commanders games this season.

It's good for the long-suffering fans of the franchise, too, who endured one em-

barrassment after another from Snyder.

Mostly, though, it's good for all of us, who needed to believe that karma would eventually get its due. Who needed the reassurance of knowing you cannot get away with being a garbage human.

Sure, Snyder is still a very wealthy man, thanks to the \$6 billion Harris and his fellow investors paid for the Commanders. He escaped appropriate punishment for a laundry list of wrongdoings, which included sexual harassment of employees and fostering a toxic and abusive workplace.

But the Commanders were Snyder's lifelong love, his fandom dating back to

else's team now, and the glow of their accomplishments this season is reflecting on someone else. It's schadenfreude that was long overdue.

Some might say it's petty to revel in Snyder's disappointment but ... too bad. Team owners are, often, a pretty shameful bunch. In the NFL alone, Jimmy and Dee Haslam broke the bank to sign an unrepentant sexual predator, then tried to justify it by smearing the women. Houston Texans owner Cal McNair used a racist slur at a team golf outing. Los Angeles Rams owner Stan Kroenke, Los Angeles Chargers owner Dean Spanos and Las Vegas Raiders owner Mark Davis gave their loyal fans the middle finger when they left town to chase shiny new stadiums.

But Snyder was in a class by himself, the worst owner in all of sports.

He clung to his team's former racist nickname for years, despite overwhelming sentiment against it. Only after sponsors started distancing themselves from the team did he finally relent. He couldn't get a stadium deal done in Virginia, Maryland OR the District of Columbia.

He was ordered by the NFL to pay \$60 million following an investigation

And let's not forget the congressional investigations of both Snyder and his franchise!

"The Commanders can't have it both ways," U.S. Rep. Jamie Raskin, D-Md., said during the House Committee on Oversight and Reform's June 2022 hearing on allegations of a toxic workplace. "You can't be constantly asking the public for subsidies and investment, and then not observing basic laws that govern the workplace."

But Snyder had long acted as if he were above reproach, be it from the NFL, the fans or outside investigators. He didn't care if he rubbed everyone the wrong way or that he was doing damage to both the franchise and league he claimed to love so much. Snyder was the owner of Washington's football team, and he was going to do as he damned well pleased.

Except win. That he could never manage, and the Commanders' quick turnaround under Harris is a further indictment of Snyder's incompetence.

Getting back to the playoffs is a triumph for the Commanders. Doing it without Snyder gloating and getting the credit makes the resurgence that much sweeter.
