


Botafogo scores early, holds off Sounders

Botafogo was not intimidated by the home crowd and used first-half goals by Jair Cunha and Igor Jesus to hold off the host Seattle Sounders, 2-1, in the Group B opener for each in the Club World Cup.

Cunha scored in the 28th minute and Igor Jesus doubled the score in the 44th. Seattle's Cristian Roldan made it 2-1 in the 75th minute.

Cunha, who is 20, used his 6-foot-6 frame for a header off a free kick from the right side by Alex Telles. Jesus also scored on a header via a cross by Vitorino while Roldan's goal deflected off Jesus.

Seattle, which qualified for the tournament by winning the 2022 Concacaf Champions League, was denied the tying goal in the final seconds of the four minutes of stoppage time when John saved a try by Pedro de la Vega on June 15.

On June 19, Seattle plays the second of its three group-stage matches at home against Atletico Madrid while Botafogo meets Paris Saint-Germain in

Pasadena, California.

Botafogo, the reigning Brazilian champion and the winner of the 2024 Copa Libertadores as the best team in South America, came out strong.

The first goal was set up by Botafogo's Artur goading Nouhou Tolo into a yellow card foul a few yards outside the box and to the right of the goal. It was a perfect spot for Telles' pinpoint, left-footed cross to Cunha.

Jesus was the beneficiary of a service by Vitorino from the right flank to make it 2-0 as goalkeeper Stefan Frei was caught leaning toward the left post as the ball from Jesus went the opposite way.

The Sounders finally came to life around the hour mark when Albert Rusnak's shot was saved by John.

It took some luck but Roldan cut the deficit in half when his diving header was redirected off Jesus and past John.

Seattle led in shot attempts 23-12, but Botafogo had six of the 11 shots on goal.

Pochettino glad to get a reaction in U.S. rout

United States Men's National Team coach Mauricio Pochettino said the 5-0 thrashing of Trinidad and Tobago in their Gold Cup opener would do his squad the world of good after they came in for stinging criticism during a four-match losing run.

The USA, which will co-host next year's World Cup with Canada and Mexico, had come under pressure after a humiliating 4-0 defeat by Switzerland in a friendly last week but found form in California to go to the top of Group D.

The U.S. was without some of its top players, including Christian Pulisic, Antonee Robinson, Weston McKennie and Yunus Musah, who have decided to skip the tournament, with the high-profile absences prompting criticism from former U.S. stalwarts Landon Donovan and Alexi Lalas.

Pochettino said it was important to start the Gold Cup with a "good feeling."

"Today's game was also a difficult

one, especially because of the negative things that happened in recent weeks," he was quoted as saying by ESPN.

"Some results that haven't gone well always generate a bit of noise. It's important for the players to have that confidence."

With the World Cup on the horizon, former Tottenham Hotspur boss Pochettino said the Gold Cup would be a chance for players to stake their claim for a place in the squad next year.

"We want to win, but at the same time it's to help the players to perform and to knock (on) the door and say, we can perform for the national team and we can be involved in the next World Cup," he added.

"That is what I expect. Win, and the player really believes that they are having the opportunity ... (to) fight for a place in the World Cup."

The U.S. tops Group D ahead of Saudi Arabia, Haiti and Trinidad and Tobago. The USA next faces the Saudis, who beat Haiti 1-0 in their opener, in Texas on June 19.

The Gold Cup runs until July 6.

Hot dog eating champ returns to rightful place July 4th

Joey Chestnut is set to return to his rightful place on the Fourth of July.

That is, competing at the Nathan's Hot Dog Eating Contest in Coney Island, New York, where he has won a record 16 championships but was banned last year because of a contractual dispute with Nathan's.

"It almost doesn't feel real yet," Chestnut, 41, told USA TODAY Sports. "I was preparing for the worst, but we

were able to work it out."

Chestnut was banned from the 2024 contest after he signed an endorsement deal with Impossible Foods that called for him to endorse the company's plant-based hot dogs. Nathan's said it viewed the hot dog as direct competition with its all-beef product.

With the 2025 contest less than three weeks away, Chestnut said he has agreed to endorse only Nathan's hot dogs as part of a three-year contract with Nathan's and International Federation of Competitive Eating (IFOCE)

Inc., which runs the annual competition. The contract was signed earlier this month, according to Chestnut.

He declined to disclose the financial terms of the deal and said he

still is working with Impossible Foods.

George Shea, the founder of IFOCE and announcer for the Nathan's contest, confirmed Chestnut is clear to compete.

"We're very excited to have Joey back and we believe this is going to be the

best contest ever," Shea told USA TODAY Sports.

With Chestnut absent last year, Patrick Bertoletti won the men's competition by eating 58 hot dogs and buns during the 10-minute contest. That was 18 shy of Chestnut's record of 76.

Chestnut, who had won 16 of the past 17 men's competitions until last year, said he began training in May for the contest.

"It'd be great to make a new record," he said. "If I can get close to 80, that'd be amazing."

NASCAR CUP SERIES POCONO WINNERS AND LOSERS

Chase Briscoe tightens playoff bubble with win

Chase Briscoe is in the NASCAR Cup Series playoffs.

Briscoe managed fuel concerns and held off Denny Hamlin and Ryan Blaney to win The Great American Getaway 400 race on June 22 at Pocono Raceway in Pennsylvania.

He is the 11th driver to win this season, and he secured a playoff berth with nine races to go in the regular season.

The winners and losers from Pocono:

Winner: Chase Briscoe

Welcome to Joe Gibbs Racing, Chase Briscoe.

He earned his first win as JGR driver at Pocono, locking into the playoffs after entering the weekend in a semi-tenuous position ahead of the playoff cutline. Briscoe and his No. 19 Toyota team navigated the strategy well enough to take the lead late in Stage 2, then kept the lead through the final stage on the final green flag stop and saving enough fuel.

Briscoe had to win the final regular-season race at Darlington last season to make the playoffs.

Winner: Amazon Prime Video's first year of NASCAR coverage

Prime Video's coverage in year one was a refreshing step forward, from the pre- and-post race coverage by Danielle Trotta, Carl Edwards and Corey Lajoie with already-created traditions to the professional in-race coverage led by Adam Alexander, Dale Earnhardt Jr. and Steve Letarte.

After three months of Fox's coverage that frankly bottomed out in 2025 with copious mistakes in production and directing along with a broadcast booth that hasn't quite clicked, Prime Video's more serious tone and style has been a refreshing change. Prime Video ensured viewers wouldn't miss a green flag lap with side-by-side coverage during commercials, and features like the Burn Bar to visually explain fuel mileage enhanced coverage.

Earnhardt and Letarte have a rapport that no one else along NASCAR's TV coverage has in 2025, which given their professional history and experience on the mic from NBC is no surprise. Alexander is a pro (even if sometimes too

positive) and has shown an ability to meet the moment this season on Prime Video and as the lead Xfinity Series voice on the CW.

The three-man booth moves with coverage to TNT, and that's a good thing. If Prime Video's coverage can help elevate TNT, NBC and Fox's work by comparison, that's a good thing.

Losers: Bubba Wallace's weekend

Bubba Wallace was encouraged after being in the top five on the practice charts June 21. That encouragement soon ended. Wallace did not make a qualifying run later in the day after his car wouldn't start, forcing him to start outside the top 30. He didn't make much ground up in the first 55 laps in the race before a brakes issue cut a tire down and forced him hard into the wall in the tunnel turn. Wallace finished 36th, a did not finish at a bad time.

Wallace will again be near the playoff bubble for the third straight season, with no wins and the wild-card available spots shrinking. He leaves Pocono in 15th in the playoff picture, 29 points ahead of 17th-place Ryan Preece.

Losers: Brad Keselowski (and crew chief Jeremy Bullins)

Brad Keselowski had a very good car in Pocono, but two unfortunate strategy moments set the No. 6 team back.

Keselowski pitted from the lead while pit road was closed in Stage 2, forcing him to the rear of the field. The miscommunication occurred with crew chief Jeremy Bullins not being aware pit road was not open.

Keselowski then was set up for the final green flag stop to take less fuel than anyone else, advancing to the cusp of the top 10 with a better fuel and tires situation. But before he planned to come in for the final stop, a caution came out due to a spin. He again lost a great deal of track position ahead of the final 35 laps, and his chances of winning (or finishing high up) were done.

Keselowski had to attempt to walk the fine line given that the No. 6 Ford needs a win to make the playoffs. Getting in via points is not an option.

But the speed is there. Can the strategy and the luck follow at some point over the next couple of months?

Road America a great spot for Palou's IndyCar party

ELKHART LAKE, WI – The Spanish winner was singing an American country song only slightly off key and nearly crashed on the cool-down lap. The third-place finisher was chugging a beer gifted by a fan.

Just another race on the NTT IndyCar Series, and just another weekend at Road America, right?

In some ways, yes.

A lush, sprawling property with 4 miles of racetrack, Road America has a reputation for attracting a fun-loving crowd and also for providing a world-class experience for drivers.

And as for Alex Palou, yeah, this year he's pretty hard to beat in 2025.

The 28-year-old spent the morning of June 22 second-guessing tire strategy, got grumpy and confused during a rough-and-tumble race, found some good luck along the way and made the XPEL Grand Prix his sixth victory in nine NTT IndyCar Series races.


"We were looking really bad at the beginning, then really good, then terrible, then really good," said Palou, who led six of the 55 laps.

Palou's latest victory was nowhere near a sure thing. He'd missed out on winning the pole a day earlier, edged by rookie Louis Foster, then got eaten up on the start by drivers who'd chosen the grippier alternate tires. Cautions early set up enough divergent pit strategies that it was impossible to guess which might work. Chip Ganassi Racing Honda teammate Scott Dixon stopped early to try to take advantage of his ability to stretch fuel and led a race-high 27 of 55 laps.

Then throw in the chaos on a 96-degree day. This race included Penske-on-Penske violence with Josef Newgarden banging wheels with both Will Power and Scott McLaughlin before crashing on his own. Sting Ray Robb got pushed off on his way to Turn 5 and crashed. Conor Daly used up all the runoff there and then some. Christian Lundgaard spun in Canada Corner and somehow escaped with no damage. Officials called seven penalties for avoidable contact, blocking and failing to follow directions.

Fortunately the track stayed fairly clean and drivers were able to pull off line to make passes or recover.

Palou became the first Indy-car

driver to win three times at Road America since Mario Andretti (1983, 1984, 1987) and Michael Andretti (1990, 1991, 1996) did in the CART era.

He also became the first driver to win six times in a season since Power in 2011. He and Kyle Kirkwood are the first two drivers to have combined to win the first nine races of a season since Johnny Rutherford and Bobby Unser in 1980.

If Palou goes on to win a fourth championship, days like this one will be a big part. He really didn't seem like he had a chance until midway through the race and didn't even necessarily seem like the favorite when he was chasing Dixon because of the doubt over fuel.

Yet there Palou was when it mattered. He survived the jostling early, had the yellow flags and pit strategy work his way and had enough speed and enough of a lead at the end.

Palou had the fuel to drive to victory lane, which surprised team manager Barry Wanser. He surprised his crew with a few lines from the song "Red Solo Cup." Palou had studied the lyrics before the race to honor a first-time sponsor if the opportunity came.

"I think the radio ... maybe with the interference on the radio maybe it didn't sound very good," Palou said. "But in my head it sounded amazing."

By then the party had been in full swing for hours.


