



US Open singles action begins

Novak Djokovic continues his quest for another US Open tennis title following an opening night victory over 19-year-old American Learner Tien on Sunday, Aug. 24.

Djokovic, who is the No. 7 seed in the tournament, appeared to be in some pain during the match. As he was being looked at by an athletic trainer during a break between sets, ESPN’s camera zoomed in during the broadcast on what appeared to be a blister on his toe.

Djokovic improved to 19-0 in first-round matches at the event. He won the event on four different occasions, with the latest coming in 2023. Djokovic has won 24 Grand Slam titles in his legendary career, and another championship in New York would set the all-time tennis record for men or women.

Djokovic will take on Zachary Svajda of the United States in the second round on Wednesday, Aug. 27. Svajda earned a convincing victory over Zsombor Piros.

American Ben Shelton also cruised on to the second round after picking up a victory over Ignacio Buse.

Top-seeded Aryna Sabalenka swept Rebeka Masarova in the first round of women’s singles. She will play Polina Kudermetova on Aug. 27. Kudermetova beat Nuria Parrizas Diaz in what ended up being a quick first-round match. Parrizas-Diaz pulled out of the match after she fell and twisted her ankle.

Raleigh sets season HR mark for catchers

The Big Dumper dinger tracker has hit another massive milestone.

Cal Raleigh set the MLB single-season record for most home runs by a catcher after hitting his league-leading 48th and 49th home runs of 2025 in the Seattle Mariners’ 11-4 win over the Athletics at T-Mobile Park on Sunday, Aug. 24.

The previous single-season mark for catchers had been owned by Salvador Perez, who mashed 48 home runs for the Kansas City Royals in 2021.

Raleigh tied Perez with a first-inning 448-foot blast off of Athletics lefty Jacob Lopez that was Big Dumper’s longest home run of the season and farthest of his career while batting from the right side of the plate. An inning later, Raleigh set the record for catchers with another homer off Lopez.

The Big Dumper’s dingers were also vital to the Mariners’ quest to win the American League West, as the victory moved Seattle to within two games of first place in the division behind the Houston Astros, who were defeated by the Baltimore Orioles.

Next possible HR milestones for Cal Raleigh

Raleigh, the 2025 Home Run Derby winner, is within striking distance of the single-season record for most home runs hit by a switch hitter.

Mickey Mantle set that standard with 54 home runs during the 1961 season; the same year his New York Yankees teammate Roger Maris broke Babe Ruth’s single-season home run record.

Raleigh also is seven home runs away from matching Ken Griffey Jr.’s Mariners record, which he set twice, by hitting 56 home runs in 1997 and 1998.

Lowry leads 6 Euro captain’s selections

European Ryder Cup captain Luke Donald’s 12-man squad looks a lot like the one that routed the U.S. in Rome two years ago by the score of 16 ½-11 ½.

Donald made his six captain’s picks on Monday, Sept. 1, to complete his team, welcoming back Shane Lowry, Ludvig Aberg, Jon Rahm, Sepp Straka, Viktor Hovland and Matt Fitzpatrick.

All six have previous Ryder Cup experience and were part of the team in 2023. In fact, the only new player on the team is Dane Rasmus Hojgaard, who replaces his twin brother Nicolai from the winning side in Rome.

Let’s take a closer look at the six captain’s picks who joined automatic qualifiers Rory McIlroy, Tommy Fleetwood, Tyrrell Hatton, Justin Rose, Robert MacIntyre and Rasmus Hojgaard.

Shane Lowry

After getting knocked out of the automatic six by Ramsus Hojgaard on the final week of qualifying, Lowry was selected by Donald and will make his third straight appearance on the European team. Lowry owns a 2-3-1 career Ryder Cup record in 2021 and 2023. The 38-year-old Irishman is ranked No. 23 in the world. He has teamed twice with Straka and once with McIlroy and Hatton. Lowry made it the Tour Champion-

ship at East Lake this season but was winless this year and hasn’t record a top-10 finish on the PGA Tour since the Truist Championship in early May.

Sepp Straka

The 32-year-old Austrian native had a banner year, winning twice this season on the PGA Tour at the American Express in January and Truist Championship in May.

Straka cooled off considerably after finishing third at the Memorial on

June 1. He made the Tour Championship but finished last. He reached a career-best No. 7 in the world earlier this season but has slipped back to No. 13. This is his second straight appearance on Team Europe. He went 1-2 in Rome in 2023.

Ludvig Aberg

The 25-year-old Swedish sensation won the Genesis Invitational at Torrey Pines in February and climbed to No. 4 in the world. He made a Sunday charge at the Masters that fizzled late and endured back-to-back missed cuts at the PGA Championship and U.S. Open. He dipped to 14 in the world but is finding better form of late. He finished T-9, T-7, T-21 in the three FedExCup Playoff events.

Aberg’s meteoric rise after turning pro in the summer of 2023 was capped off by going 2-2 in Rome in 2023, including partnering with Viktor Hovland for a 9-and-7 beat down of Scottie Scheffler and Brooks Koepka.

Viktor Hovland

The Norwegian is back for his third consecutive tour of duty on Team Europe. Hovland won the Valspar Championship in March and finished third at the U.S. Open but continues to search for the form that had him at the peak of his game in 2023 in Rome. He’s

dropped from No. 3 in the world to No. 15.

Hovland, 27, could be a pivotal player in determining the outcome of the Ryder Cup. In 2021 he went 0-3-2 in Europe’s defeat at Whistling Straits but made amends for his performance with a 3-1-1 record in Team Europe’s victory in 2023.

Jon Rahm

The Spaniard, 30, joins Tyrrell Hatton as one of two LIV Golf members on Team Europe. Rahm made some noise at the PGA Championship (T-7) and U.S. Open (T-8) and his LIV team won the team title. Also, he claimed the individual title, but the Ryder Cup will likely make or break his year. Rahm will represent Team Europe for the fourth consecutive Cup and holds a lifetime record of 6-3-3.

Matt Fitzpatrick

The 30-year-old Englishman admitted his game has taken a dip since his victory at the 2023 U.S. Open, but he rediscovered his mojo after the Masters in April, stringing together 16 straight cuts made worldwide and six top-10 finishes. Fitzpatrick, who fell to No. 34 in the world, didn’t make it to East Lake this year, but has shown he’s on the rebound. Can he keep it going at the Ryder Cup, which has been a bugaboo for him? He has a career mark of 1-7 lifetime.

Mr. Saturday dominates Darlington on Sunday

Mr. Saturday did a whole lot of haulin’ on Sunday.

Chase Briscoe, who just missed winning his seventh pole of the season on Aug. 30, controlled the Cook Out Southern 500 at Darlington Raceway on Aug. 31. He started second behind Denny Hamlin and led 309 laps on his way to victory lane.

The next-closest driver to his laps-led total was John Hunter Nemechek with 15.

And his prize? Briscoe became the first driver to lock himself into the second round of the NASCAR Cup Series Playoffs. Two races remain in the Round of 16.

“I feel like this is what we’re definitely capable of doing,” he said on the USA Network broadcast. “We haven’t been able to go out and dominate a race like that, but the potential’s been there from day one.”

Briscoe also won the Southern 500 in 2024. Tyler Reddick and Erik Jones

challenged him late but ultimately followed in second and third.

Here are three takeaways.

1. Chase Briscoe repeats as Southern 500 champion

Briscoe’s 2024 triumph during the regular-season finale at Darlington vaulted him into the Playoffs. This year it pushed him to the second round.

But even with all the laps in front, Reddick and Jones made runs at him late. Reddick had a chance to steal the lead in the final two turns. He crossed the stripe four-tenths of a second behind Briscoe. Jones was five-tenths of a tick behind the winner.

The Southern 500 marked the second victory of Briscoe’s 2025 campaign, with the other coming in June at Pocono. This was the fourth win of his Cup Series career.

During his first year in the No. 19 car after inheriting it from retired Martin Truex Jr., Briscoe has shown speed all season. He’s won six of his eight career poles this season.

“There at the end, that was way hard-

er than it needed to be,” Briscoe said. “Man, just an incredible Bass Pro Shops Toyota. As a fan, I’ve watched Martin kind of dominate a lot of races. It was fun to finally be behind the wheel of it. So cool to win two Southern 500s in a

row. This is my favorite race of the year.”

In his last eight events, Briscoe has tallied five top-five finishes, with three runners-up and now a dub.

2. These NASCAR Playoff drivers struggled at Darlington

From Briscoe’s dominance ... to these guys.

Three playoff drivers placed in the 30s. Alex Bowman and Shane van Gisbergen took back-to-back spots, with Bowman at 31 and SVG at 32. Josh Berry ranked 38th, dead last.

Berry’s tough night revealed itself right away. He got loose on the first lap, colliding with Tyler Reddick and suffering enough damage he had to go behind the wall. He did return but ended up 128 laps down.

Bowman entered the postseason as the last driver to sneak in. Van Gisbergen’s 32nd placement isn’t really a surprise – he’s been mediocre on ovals like Darlington but unreal on road courses.

Fellow playoff participant Christopher Bell also finished 29th.

All of them have ground to make up.

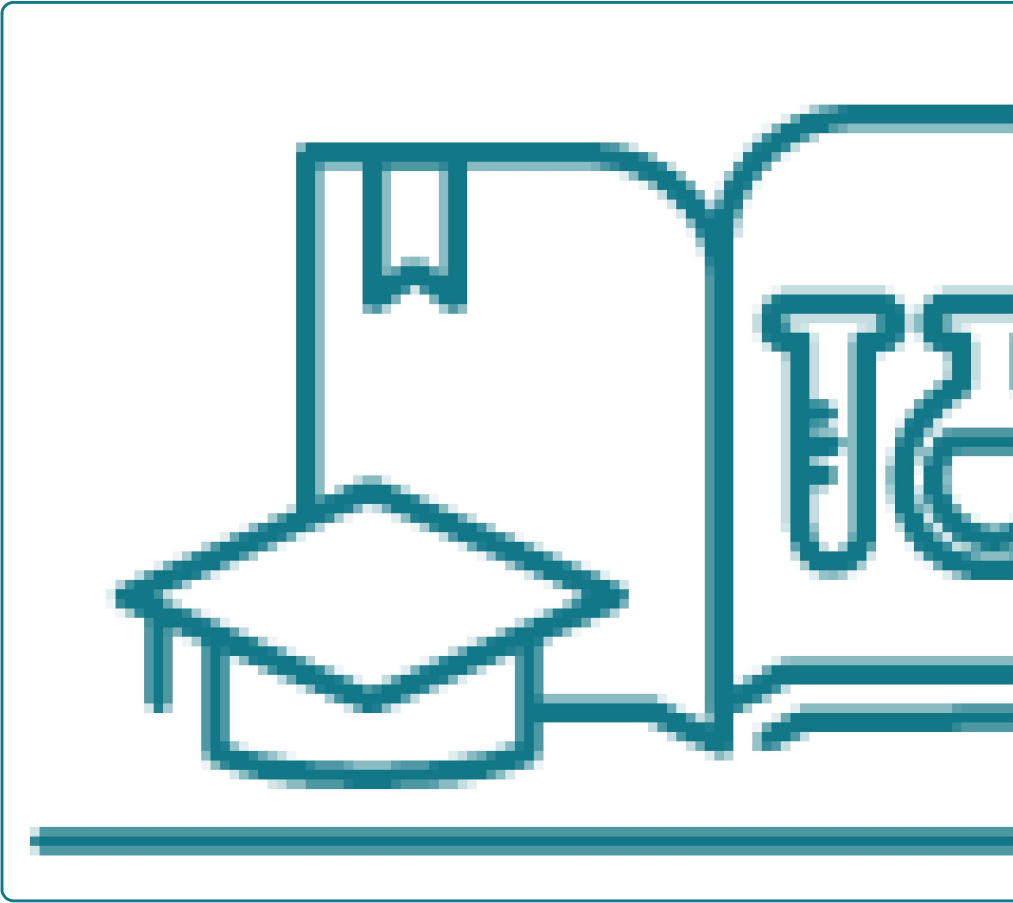

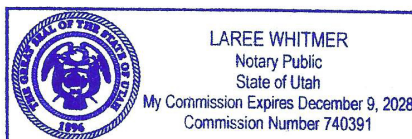
