Sourcewell, a State of Minnesota local government unit and service cooperative, is requesting proposals for Vehicle Exhaust Removal and Filtering Systems to result in a procurement solution for use by its Participating Entities. Sourcewell Participating Entities include thousands of governmental, higher education, K-12 education, nonprofit, tribal government, and other public agencies located in the United States and Canada. Only proposals submitted through the Sourcewell Procurement Portal will be considered. Proposals are due no later than December 9, 2025 at 4:30 p.m. Central Time, and late proposals will not be considered.

The findings of the Proposal Evaluation Committee are summarized as follows:

The Proposal Evaluation Committee applied the Sourcewell RFP evaluation criteria and determined that the products and/or services offered in the proposal response from DPF Services LLC fall outside of the Requested Equipment, Products, or Services of the RFP. All other proposals were found to meet the scope and mandatory submittal requirements and were evaluated.

Air Purifiers Inc., is a distributor, reseller, and service provider with 40 years of providing vehicle exhaust removal, air filtration, and industrial ventilation systems. Air Purifiers provides coverage to participating entities

across the United States and Canada through its direct, in-house sales and service team, with local partners used where needed for installation and support. Air Purifiers offers a broad portfolio of direct-source vehicle exhaust capture systems, overhead rail and hose systems, boom arms, portable exhaust removal units, in-ground and underfloor systems, ventilation and make-up air systems, filtration equipment, and related installation, commissioning, maintenance, and training services. Offering a single point of responsibility, they combine engineering, product supply, installation, and commissioning services into its turnkey delivery model. They offer a competitive discount from list price for equipment, accessories, and replacement parts, while labor, installation, and freight are quoted separately based on project scope.

Jobbers Equipment Warehouse Inc., established in 1962, is a distributor and service provider that offers a comprehensive portfolio of direct-source capture systems, overhead rail and hose systems, boom arms, portable exhaust removal units, in-ground and underfloor systems, garage ventilation products, and related installation, maintenance, and support services. Jobbers provide coverage to participating entities across the United States and Canada through a combination of its in-house team, manufacturer representatives, and certified regional service providers. Jobbers provide a single-source approach, combining in-house CAD design, installation, permitting, and service with direct factory partnerships. Jobbers offer participating entities a competitive discount range on product category, configuration, and purchase volume. Installation, freight, and other project-related services are quoted separately.

Plymovent Corporation, established in 1975, is a manufacturer of vehicle exhaust extraction and air filtration systems. Plymovent's distributor-based service model, provides local support for design, installation, training, and ongoing service to participating entities across the United States and Canada. Plymovent offers its full exhaust extraction catalog, including source capture systems for emergency response and maintenance applications, ambient air filtration units, and related services. A competitive discount from list price applies to their entire catalog, while installation, freight, and other project costs are quoted by the local distributor on project basis. An additional discount is offered on multiple facilities on one single contract.

Rossman Enterprises, Inc., established in 1982 and doing business as MagneGrip, is a U.S. manufacturer of vehicle exhaust removal and air purification systems. The company offers coverage to participating entities across the United States and Canada through its internal team and authorized distributors. They offer direct exhaust capture systems, air purification units, and related installation and service, with their combined exhaust-capture and ambient air-purification approach as a market differentiator. Pricing is competitive and is based on a discount from published list price, while installation and freight are quoted by project.
