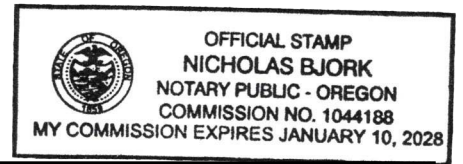



National title hopefuls gird for league play

The college men's basketball season is less than two months old, yet it's already becoming clear who is capable of winning a national championship.

As conference play begins in earnest, there's no more easy victories against cupcakes, and you find out if your team is the real deal or not.

Some squads have already proved themselves and look like they're on a warpath toward the NCAA Tournament Final Four in Indianapolis. Others may not have those impressive victories, but their records can't be denied and may be worth paying attention to.

Which ones have the best shot at cutting down the nets inside Lucas Oil Stadium on April 6? We rank the top 10 candidates, as well as teams just on the outside and those intriguing options that still have some more to prove as non-conference play ends.

Potential/wait-and-see

● *Vanderbilt, Nebraska, Arkansas, Tennessee, Illinois, Virginia, Southern Cal, Georgia*

This field features a mix of surprises but also teams that haven't lived up to preseason hype just yet. It starts with Vanderbilt and Nebraska, two teams that are still undefeated and playing great ball. However, the schedule hasn't been challenging. The same could be said for one-loss teams in Virginia, USC and Georgia.

Then there's Arkansas, Tennessee and Illinois, teams that have stumbled against some top talent but have picked up some notable wins in between. It's obvious what's holding them back, and when those issues are fixed, it's led to those important Quad 1 wins. It's just a matter of whether they can find consistency to put some more belief in.

Just on the outside

● *North Carolina, Louisville, Kansas, Alabama, Texas Tech*

A group of teams that are bound for the second weekend of the NCAA Tournament, but that's not the ceiling. North Carolina doesn't look like a bubble team anymore and just needs some more key wins. Louisville's offense is elite but hasn't been on every night. Despite Kansas, Alabama and Texas Tech having had some bad nights against top-tier competition, each of them has responded well and at full strength can compete with anyone.

Top 10 national title contenders

10. Houston

Last season's national runner-up reloaded with a tremendous recruiting class and is back to making life difficult for opposing offenses. The only issue has been the Cougars haven't played to the same level with the ball, leading to some results that are too close for comfort. Despite that, Houston is 11-1 and the inexperienced players on the team are only going to get better, and it's already showing. It won't be long before the Cougars fit the mold of what a Kelvin Sampson team looks like.

9. BYU

The hype of AJ Dybantsa's arrival has been backed up with a 12-1 start to the season. To try to prove it was legit, BYU scheduled a worthy nonconference slate, and it's done the job with a 3-1 Quad 1 record, the lone blemish a two-point loss to UConn. However, the wins have lost some luster as they weren't as noteworthy as initially hoped. So, this

remains a largely untested team. That shouldn't be a reason to sell any Cougars stock, as BYU should more than hold its own against a crowded Big 12.

8. Michigan State

Tom Izzo still has it with Sparty off to another incredible start to the season. Michigan State is 11-1, and not only has it picked up wins against Arkansas, Kentucky, North Carolina and Iowa, but the Spartans mostly looked far superior in those outings. The loss was a tough one to Duke that just got away. The mix of young and veterans has blended well with Jeremy Fears Jr. playing like an All-American guard. The offense has slowed down a bit, but there isn't a reason Michigan State shouldn't be able to defend its Big Ten regular-season title.

7. Purdue

The preseason No. 1 team certainly looks capable of finishing the season in that spot with some dominant showings against quality opponents in Alabama, Texas Tech and Auburn. The only thing preventing it from being in the top five was the dreaded home blowout to Iowa State. Maybe that loss was what Purdue needed as it's been crushing teams since then. The Boilermakers are elite on both sides of the ball, and Braden Smith is en route to national player of the year consideration, leading the country in assists per game (9.6).

6. Gonzaga

Another competitive nonconference schedule, another season of Gonzaga proving it's a powerful force. The Bulldogs have ran right through nearly everyone they've played with double-digit victories in 11 of their 12 wins. No team is better at getting the ball in the hoop, averaging a nation-leading 34.8 made shots per game. But when the Zags played in what many thought was a national championship game preview against Michigan, they stood no chance in a 30-point romp by the Wolverines. Best believe that's going to be on Gonzaga's mind the rest of the season as it is poised to run through the West Coast Conference one last time.

5. Duke

Everyone thought last season's Duke team – led by Cooper Flagg – was one of its best in recent memory. There's a chance this one is even better than the 2024-25 Final Four squad. The Blue Devils have been incredible to watch so far, passing nearly every test that's been thrown at them. They've been able to win at home, on the road or at neutral sites, and it's all thanks to arguably the best freshman in the country so far in Cameron Boozer, who leads Division I with 23.2 points per game. They shoot the ball well but the defense is even better, allowing more than 75 points only once in the one-point loss to Texas

Tech. Jon Scheyer has a great chance for back-to-back Final Four appearances for the first time since the program went to five straight from 1988 to 1992.

4. Iowa State

It's time to put some respect on Iowa State, which has continuously proved it is not to be messed with. The 12-0 Cyclones have been relentless offensively, shooting 53.4% from the field, second-best in the country, along with a 41.6% mark from 3-point (fourth in Division I). It's hard to keep up with when Iowa State is forcing more than 18 turnovers per game. The Cyclones don't own many ranked wins, but there may be no greater win so far for any team than the 23-point rout it put on Purdue in Mackey Arena. Iowa State has so much experience spread out in its rotation, and that veteran-led group can get the Cyclones to the Final Four for the first time since 1944.

3. UConn

Dan Hurley has shaken off the up-and-down 2024-25 results and has assembled the right roster to put the Huskies right back in the national championship picture. The defense has been what's gotten UConn back to being a dominant force, ranking sixth in scoring defense, giving up just 61.1 points per game. It had a really loaded first month of the season that included five ranked opponents in four weeks. The Huskies went 4-1 with the loss at home to Arizona, and it got wins over BYU and at Kansas. The Huskies have proved they can win away from home and look miles ahead of the rest of the Big East, which means a No. 1 seed and playing close to home is very much in play for UConn to go for a third title in four seasons.

2. Arizona

Arizona has typically gotten out to fast starts under Tommy Lloyd, yet this season might be its best yet. The Wildcats are 12-0 and have made a tremendous case to be the top team in the country. It hasn't looked back since the season-opening win against Florida, not only picking up five ranked victories, but looking mostly dominant in those cases. It wasn't easy going across the country into Connecticut to win, and it owns "The Yellowhammer State" after beating Auburn and Alabama each in dominant fashion. The schedule is favorable where the Wildcats could remain undefeated going into the final weekend of January as this team has the makings of being the one to finally end the 25-year Final Four drought.

1. Michigan

The top national championship contender is the most dominant team in the country, as Michigan has stormed its way through the start of the season. The additions of Yaxel Lendeborg and Aday Mara have given coach Dusty May one of the most lethal units that is blowing out nearly everyone it plays. After a couple of close early wins, the Wolverines have won by double-digits in its past eight games, with an average margin of victory at 34.3 points. That includes the perfect showing at the Players Era Festival that was capped by the 40-point victory over Gonzaga. Michigan averages 95.4 points per game and has eclipsed the century mark in five of its past six games. It doesn't look like this team is slowing down, and it looks like it will run through what is already a challenging Big Ten. Everything about Michigan screams a team that can win it all.

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MLB offseason has been agonizingly slow

Groundhog Day might be a month away, but in baseball free agency, groundhog day has been going on for the past 64 days.

Virtually every day is the same. Rumors are floated. Teams check in. Teams check out.

And most of the top free agents still remain unsigned.

Spring training starts in less than seven weeks, and the likes of Kyle Tucker, Alex Bregman and Framber Valdez remain unemployed.

It's a market that gobbled up the top relievers, with every available free agent closer, from Edwin Diaz (Los Angeles Dodgers) to Devin Williams (New York Mets) to Robert Suarez (Atlanta), signing in the first five weeks. The biggest sluggers signed with Pete Alonso getting \$155 million from the Baltimore Orioles and Kyle Schwarber returning to the Philadelphia Phillies for \$150M.

But top free agent starting pitchers outside Dylan Cease (\$210 million) haven't signed and there are countless others looking for jobs, or at least contract offers to their satisfaction.

So, what in the world is taking so long in this slow drip of a free agency? No one is blaming the upcoming labor negotiations with a potential lockout in December, and no one hints at collusion.

So what is it? "The key word is methodical. 'I just don't see any urgency,'" an agent said.

USA TODAY Sports canvassed a handful of executives and agents who came up with the top five reasons:

1. Big-market teams – besides Blue Jays – yet to swim deep in free agency

The Blue Jays have spent \$337 mil-

lion this winter in free agency, signing four of the 15 free agents who have received contracts of at least \$30 million.

Even after signing infielder Kazuma Okamoto to a four-year, \$60 million contract, with a formal press conference scheduled for Tuesday Jan. 6, they still want to add another power hitter. Their preference is to make Okamoto a super utility player.

The Blue Jays remain fully engaged in talks with infielders Bo Bichette and Bregman, with outfielder Tucker also remaining a possibility.

While the Blue Jays are trying to be the Dodgers of the North, their competitors in the American League East – except the Orioles – are standing back in awe.

The New York Yankees have spent \$29 million. The Boston Red Sox, who remain the favorite for Bregman, have been active on the trade market but haven't spent a penny in free agency.

There are 21 teams who have spent less than \$60 million this winter, including big-market teams like the Chicago Cubs, Red Sox, Yankees, San Francisco Giants, Texas Rangers and Los Angeles Angels.

"Major markets are waiting for another market in the same market," another agent said. "When you do that, you lose."

2. Teams exploring trades before spending big on free agents

The Miami Marlins are listening to trade offers for starting pitcher Edward Cabrera, with the Yankees, Mets, Cubs and Orioles all still showing interest.

The Milwaukee Brewers still are listening on offers for ace Freddy Peralta.

The Arizona Diamondbacks have been aggressively shopping but now are pessimistic about trading All-Star second baseman Ketel Marte. No one has come close to meeting their price.

And if Marte is still aboard, Bregman is definitely out of the D-backs' plans.

The St. Louis Cardinals are aggressively shopping infielder/outfielder Brendan Donovan and third baseman Nolan Arenado. And the Washington

Nationals have been shopping starter MacKenzie Gore and shortstop CJ Abrams.

Teams like the Red Sox have chosen to hit the trade market instead of pushing all of their chips into free agency, landing starters Sonny Gray and Johan Oviedo, as well as Willson Contreras.

As long as there's trade inventory, it slows down the free agent market.

3. Bullpens took priority

"I've never seen anything like it," one veteran GM said. "Relief pitching was everyone's first priority, it seems like. The rest of the market came to a standstill."

You name it, the top relievers all went and got paid well.

The top nine relievers all were signed before the holidays, earning a combined \$292 million:

- Diaz: \$69 million, three years, Dodgers.
- Williams: \$51 million, three years, Mets.
- Suarez: \$45 million, three years, Atlanta.
- Tyler Rogers: \$37 million, three years, Blue Jays.
- Ryan Helsley, \$28 million, two years, Orioles.
- Emilio Pagan, \$20 million, two years, Reds.
- Kyle Finnegan, \$19 million, two years, Tigers.
- Pete Fairbanks, \$13 million, one year, Marlins.
- Kenley Jansen, \$10 million, one year, Tigers.

4. Five-tool guys are way away from a deal

Schwarber received a five-year, \$150 million contract from Phillies, but he was in such demand that even the Pittsburgh Pirates and Cincinnati Reds were in serious pursuit, with the Reds even willing to offer more until Schwarber told them it wasn't necessary.

Meanwhile, Tucker, Cody Bellinger, Bregman and Bichette all remain unsigned, with no indication that any of them are close to a deal.

"It's been such an abnormality than years' past," one executive said.

While the Red Sox are the favorites to bring back Bregman, and the Yankees' No. 1 priority is the return of Bellinger, the Mets are still looming in the Bellinger derby while the Cubs remain in

pursuit of Bregman for the second consecutive winter.

The Tucker market is the biggest mystery. He was projected to earn a contract in the \$400 million neighborhood but could have to instead take a higher average annual value offer on a short-term contract and hit the market again after two consecutive injury-plagued second halves.

"The major markets," one agent said, "are still power dry."

5. This may be the new normal

Really, the advent of free agency should be in January, and not in November for the stars of the game.

Everyone always waits for free agents' price tags to plummet, or at least for the years to drop, and nothing ever seems to get done until close to spring training or even in March.

Bryce Harper and Manny Machado were the two biggest stars in the winter of 2019 and had to wait until after spring training before they got the deals they desired, with Harper signing a 13-year, \$330 million deal with the Phillies and Machado a 10-year, \$300 million contract with the Padres.

Bregman didn't sign his three-year, \$120 million contract with the Red Sox until spring training last year, in which he opted out, and now waits for a five- or six-year contract.

Players have learned to be patient, knowing at some point some team will blink.

"In my opinion, executives really struggle as far as decision-making now," one agent said. "They just collect so much more information and then figure out how to utilize it."

So now that the holidays are over, and everyone is back to work, will the free agent floodgates now open?

Not so fast.

This is salary arbitration week with teams and players exchanging salary arbitration numbers on Thursday Jan. 8, which will consume most of their time.

Maybe next week.

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Texas Tech signs star transfer QB Sorsby

Brendan Sorsby, the top quarterback in the transfer portal, has signed a letter of intent with Texas Tech, a person with intimate knowledge of the situation told USA TODAY Sports.

Sorsby, who had 36 total touchdowns and 3,380 total yards for Cincinnati in 2025, was being pursued by nearly every major Power conference program looking for a quarterback, including new LSU coach Lane Kiffin.

Sorsby began his career at Indiana and spent two seasons (one redshirt) with the Hoosiers before transferring to Cincinnati. Sorsby has 82 touchdowns over the past three seasons and is the dual-threat quarterback Texas Tech wanted to replace senior Behren Morton.

The Red Raiders won the Big 12 for the first time in school history in 2025 and were the No. 4 seed in the College Foot-

ball Playoff. A limited offense, however, was exposed in a 23-0 loss to Oregon in the Orange Bowl quarterfinal.

Texas Tech billionaire booster Cody Campbell and his partners at Double Eagle Development spent \$25 million on the 2025 roster, and Campbell told USA TODAY Sports on Jan. 1 they would "double down" on that investment for the 2026 season.

"Let's goooo! Texas Tech got a taste this year, want more, and are building a dynasty," Campbell posted on social media Sunday night Jan. 4. "We are hungrier and more committed than ever before! Each Texas Tech player will be surrounded and supported by an elite cast of teammates, a sound culture and program, a solid and stable coaching staff, the best facilities in the country, and the most passionate and committed fan base in America!"

Sorsby is a critical beginning to the investment. He has thrown for 7,208 career yards, and 60 touchdowns and rushed for 1,305 yards and 22 TDs.

Top portal WR Nick Marsh commits to Indiana for '26

Indiana football is focused on winning a national title for the 2025 college football season, but Curt Cignetti is already building for 2026.

On Sunday Jan. 4, four days before the No. 1 Hoosiers are set to play No. 5 Oregon in the Peach Bowl, Indiana added a commitment from former Michigan State wide receiver Nick Marsh. The sophomore had 59 receptions for 662 yards and six touchdowns for the Spartans in 2025.

Marsh, listed at 6-foot-3 and 203 pounds, will have two more years of eligibility for the Hoosiers. He is the first addition out of the transfer portal in this cycle for the Hoosiers. Against Indiana this season Marsh finished with seven catches for 64 yards and a score in a 38-13 Indiana victory.

Wide receiver is a major area of need for the Hoosiers this offseason. Wide receivers Elijah Sarratt, E.J. Williams and Jonathan Brady are out of eligibility following the season, while redshirt junior Omar Cooper, Jr. could enter the NFL draft.

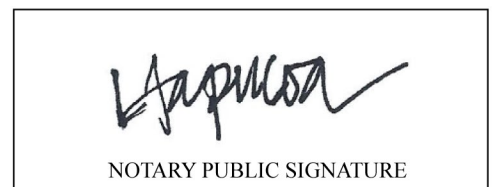


