



# A'ja Wilson making the case for fourth MVP award

CHICAGO – Don't hold A'ja Wilson's greatness against her.

There has been some thought, aided by the Las Vegas Aces' rocky start, that this was going to be the season for someone else to win MVP. That as otherworldly as Wilson is, the wealth should be shared.

That's not fair, though. To Wilson or the game.

"There's not a more dominant player," Aces coach Becky Hammon said Monday, Aug. 25, after Wilson dropped 18 points and nine rebounds in a 79-74 win over the Chicago Sky that extended Las Vegas' winning streak to 11 and clinched a playoff spot.

"If you had to pick one right now – you could pick anybody in the league and you got one game to win, who are you taking? That answers your question. Or if you start with that as the question: Who's as good as A'ja Wilson? That's the point."

Hammon is, of course, biased. Wilson, the league's MVP in three of the past five seasons, is the driving force for Las Vegas, offensively and defensively. The Aces don't have those titles in 2022 and 2023, or that trip to the semifinals last year, without Wilson.

But Hammon also has a point.

Wilson leads the league in total points scored and is a close second to Napheesa Collier in scoring average. She also is No. 1 in rebounding, blocks and that all-important player efficiency measure. She's the only player to rank in the top three in points, rebounds, steals

and blocks.

Really, though, Wilson's game has been next-level since ... well, since South Carolina.

She has been top 10 in scoring, rebounding, blocks and efficiency every year she's been in the WNBA. And most years, she's been first or second in each of those categories. Wilson reached 5,500 points and 2,000 rebounds faster than anyone in WNBA history and is also the only player with three games of at least 30 points, 10 rebounds and five blocks.

"It gets lost a little bit, and I don't think that's fair. I mean, the way that she shows up every single night, I think people get used to it," said Jackie Young,

who has played alongside Wilson her entire career.

"She puts up the numbers every single night, and because she's won three MVPs, I don't think that it should get lost," Young added. "She's still putting up these numbers every single night, and I think she should be rewarded for that."

This is not a slight against Collier, or the season she's having. But there is a tendency to hold transcendent players to higher standards, to judge them against themselves rather than their peers. To get so used to someone being exceptional that it becomes the expectation.

There is also a very real "fatigue"

factor. Was Charles Barkley really the NBA MVP in 1993? Or were people just tired of seeing Michael Jordan win everything? Same for Karl Malone in 1997. Nikola Jokic has three MVPs, but Hammon thinks he deserved a fourth.

"The way he impacts a game with the passing and the rebounding and the scoring, he just is so dominant in every kind of which way. A'ja has a similar dominant stat line," said Hammon, who spent eight years as an assistant with the San Antonio Spurs of the NBA before being hired to coach the Aces.

"She just impacts every area of the game. First in total points. First in total rebounds. First in total blocks. Blocks, steals. She's everywhere. She's everywhere," Hammon said, drawing out that last word. "That's dominance."

With the Aces' struggles at the beginning of the season – after a 9-11 start there were some doubts about the playoffs – and the dominance of Collier and the Minnesota Lynx, Wilson was, for the first time in several years, largely absent from early MVP debates. Collier, who finished second to Wilson last year, was the favorite.

Might still be, though Collier's absence for seven games because of a sprained ankle and the Aces' second-half tear have put Wilson squarely back in the conversation. Wilson is averaging 26.2 points, 12.7 rebounds, 2.5 assists, 1.8 blocks and 1.5 steals a game during Las Vegas' 11-game winning streak.

On Tuesday, Aug. 26, she was named the Western Conference Player of the Week for a third consecutive week.

"She's going to be the greatest player to ever play this game when it's all said and done," Hammon said. "Don't miss it."

And never, ever take her greatness for granted.

# Steady Pegula on to US Open semifinals

NEW YORK – American Jessica Pegula had little trouble against Barbora Krejčíková, overwhelming the two-time Grand Slam champion 6-3, 6-3 and setting up a rematch in the US Open semifinals with top-ranked and No. 1 seed Aryna Sabalenka.

Sabalenka was set to face Markéta Vondrušová, the 2023 Wimbledon champion, in the first night session on Tuesday, Sept. 2, and beat Pegula in the US Open final last year. But Vondrušová withdrew from the tournament two hours before her match with an injury.

The crowd at Arthur Ashe Stadium barely had time to get settled into their seats for the 11:30 a.m. ET start time Sept. 2 when Pegula took control early with her forehand and Krejčíková's inability to sustain any offensive rhythm, even completely whiffing on an attempted forehand chance in the second game.

"I think I've been playing some really good tennis," No. 4 seed Pegula said after the match. "I've just been playing very solid. I've been having very good quick starts, so I really wanted to do that today, especially against someone like (Krejčíková) who's very dangerous."

"I feel really comfortable. It's crazy to feel this comfortable on the biggest court in the world with the craziest crowd and the best players. Ten years ago, I never thought I'd be good at this, but I guess I am."

Pegula didn't break much of a sweat at the start, racing out to 3-0 and 4-1 leads within the first 20 minutes, looking like the player who had only spent four hours on the court in her first four matches of the tournament, while not losing a set.

But Krejčíková fought back, winning two straight games before letting it slip away when serving for the equalizer, and was broken for the third time in the first set.

Krejčíková is known more for her outstanding career in doubles, having already secured the career Grand Slam in women's doubles and won a gold medal at the Paris Olympics. She was undone against Pegula by untimely errors with her backhand and an unreliable second serve.


Pegula, at 31, is the oldest woman remaining in the singles tournament, and she is seeking her first Grand Slam championship. Pegula is the first woman to reach back-to-back US Open semifinals without dropping a set since Serena Williams (2011-14).

## Djokovic tops No. 4 Fritz

Novak Djokovic, all of 38 years old, is on to the US Open men's singles semifinals again, after taking 3 hours and 24 minutes to oust No. 4 seed Taylor Fritz 6-3, 7-5, 3-6, 6-4 in the quarterfinals and extending his dominance in the head-to-head matchup. Djokovic, the No. 7 seed, moved to 11-0 against Fritz, the 2024 US Open finalist, and has beaten the last 21 Americans he has faced in Grand Slam events.

It will be the 14th US Open semifinal in Djokovic's career, tying Jimmy Connors for most in tournament history. He also became the oldest man to reach the semifinals since Connors' epic run in 1991.

With Fritz's defeat, there are no American men left in the tournament, extending the country's Grand Slam championship drought to 22 years, a streak that began after Andy Roddick's victory at the 2003 US Open. Djokovic

improved to 16-0 vs. Americans at the tournament.

## Venus Williams' doubles run ends

Venus Williams' US Open is over after she and her doubles partner, Leylah Fernandez, were routed 6-1, 6-2 in their quarterfinal match by the No. 1 seeds, Taylor Townsend and Katerina Siniakova.

Williams and Fernandez had never played doubles together and entered the tournament as a wild-card entry. They

surprised many by winning three matches, including a third-round tilt against the No. 12 seeds, Ekaterina Alexandrova and Shuai Zhang. After that match, Williams implored her younger sister, and former doubles partner, Serena, to show up at Flushing Meadows for additional support.

But this destruction took all of 56 minutes, as Townsend and Siniakova exerted their experience together, powering to the semifinals with 19 winners and an 88% win rate on first serves.

Townsend and Siniakova, who won Wimbledon in 2024 and the Australian Open in January, moved on to the semifinals Wednesday, Sept. 3 to take on No. 4 seed Veronika Kudermetova and Elise Mertens, who won their matchup over Mirra Andreeva and Diana Shnaider, the No. 5 seed, in straight sets.

The 45-year-old Williams, a seven-time Grand Slam singles champion, returned to the court earlier this summer after taking a 16-month break. She had not mentioned retirement and has continued to play competitive tennis, in both singles and doubles, since returning from her hiatus.

"I don't know. I was so focused on this tournament here. I really felt like we had a chance to really continue to play into the tournament," Williams said when asked about her post-US Open plans. "So I haven't given that any thought. I do have commitments, you know, places I said I'd be, people expecting me to be there, like, the next few weeks. So I have to go and show up."

"But I'm very serious about my commitments. I would never want to cancel now, so I'll try to keep those. If there is opportunity for me to play, then hopefully I can get back somewhere this year. I just don't know. I really don't."


