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U.S. jumpers say they're not injecting

MILANO – The three ski jumpers on the United States men's Olympic team had something on their minds other than their 2026 Winter Games competition that started Monday Feb. 9 at 11:30 a.m. ET.

They also were thinking about so-called "PenisGate," rumors that ski jumpers have gotten penis-enlarging injections of hyaluronic acid to increase the distance of their jumps. U.S. Ski said it was all "wild rumor," and the World Anti-Doping Agency said it will investigate to see if there is any evidence.

All three U.S. ski jumpers were adamant they're not doing it. But they didn't rule out competitors getting the injections.

"It is difficult to say if it's something that has been done or if people are doing," said Jason Colby, a 19-year-old based in Steamboat Springs, Colorado, who will be competing in his first Olympics.

"And I guess that, scientifically speaking, it could work. But who knows what other teams are doing behind closed doors."

Kevin Bickner, who competed at the Winter Olympics in 2018 and 2022, told USA TODAY Sports he thinks the use of injections "certainly is possible."

"But I don't think that this is a problem in the sport," said Bickner, a 29-year-old native of the Chicago area. "I've never heard of anyone doing this."

"Definitely no one on (Team USA) is

doing this.

"We're close with several countries on the circuit. As far as I know, none of them are doing it. If it was to be done, it would be ... a one- or two-people type of thing. And I guess, theoretically, there is a way for it to happen."

Tate Frantz, a 20-year-old born in Lake Placid, New York, and the third member of the team, told USA TODAY Sports, "Can't speak for any other teams

... but who knows what other teams are doing behind closed doors."

What is it about the crotch?

The head coach and assistant coach of the Norway men's team were suspended for 18 months for their role in manipulating suits at the 2025 Nordic ski world championships.

In all cases, the attempt to enlarge

the suit had taken place in the crotch area – the same area that would be targeted by penis-enlarging injections.

"It's definitely the spot on a suit that can make the biggest difference," Bickner said. "So there is a lot of emphasis on trying to make that part of your equipment as efficient as possible."

"But I think there are methods that most people would come up with before deciding that they wanted to inject themselves with something."

Having an enlarged crotch would create an advantage, according to Frantz.

"It's more of a question of, is an actual injection a way that somebody has done this?" Frantz said.

"And that's what I'm unable to answer or really still am uncertain of myself."

Wanted or unwanted attention?

None of the jumpers expressed resentment about the rumored injections generating a lot more attention than the competition.

"It's been a funny thing to watch go down," Bickner said. "It might not be the greatest thing to get attention for, but I've noticed a lot more people in America paying attention to ski jumping, which is cool."

"So we're excited to represent our country. We're excited to have eyes on us now, and hopefully we can put this weirdness behind us and have people focus more on the sport because it's a really cool sport and we want to represent it well."

Britcher's yellow sled makes luger smile

CORTINA D'AMPEZZO, Italy – It's impossible to miss USA luger Summer Britcher on the track.

Her yellow sled is incredibly distinct. It stands out against the white ice beneath her. It clashes with her red, white and blue suit. And it caught the attention of the writers room at "Saturday Night Live," which aired a sketch Jan. 31 parodying NBC's Winter Olympics promo where cast member Jane Wickline played a reluctant luger – sliding on a yellow sled – coached by special guest Alexander Skarsgård.

"My boyfriend sent it to me," Britcher said Friday Feb. 6 when asked about the sketch. "And as I was watching it, just more and more the details stood out. I was like, 'Hey, hang on a second! That sled's an interesting color!'"

The difference between Britcher and Wickline's character "Gertie Burper" – who hates the luge because "it's way too fast" and "scares me to death" – is that Britcher is teeming with excitement at this, her fourth Olympic Games. She had media at Friday's USA Luge press conference cackling with constant jokes and wisecracks at the podium, like lob-

bying to borrow a helicopter to Milan for figure skating and sharing a "personal request" to mic up teammate Ansel Haugsjaa while the whole team is "strutting" at the opening ceremony. It'd be "a treat for the whole world."

It's all part of her intention to "appreciate the process" and "enjoy every race"

as she has all season. She's trying desperately to hold onto that mindset in Cortina, knowing it's been a determining factor of her success, while also being acutely aware of how results build pressure and expectations.

Positivity was actually the impetus for her unique sled choice.

Eight or so years ago, her pod (luge sled) got hit during shipment, causing two chunks of paint to chip off. As a joke, she drew a curved line under them to make a smiley face. Which annoyed her old coach Bill Tavares. But it stuck. Even after she retired that sled, Britcher continued to draw smiley faces on whatever pod she used for every race.

For a while, she thought about getting a yellow sled to go all-in on the smiley face motif. It wasn't until this season that she actually decided to do it.

"It's kind of a risky color move ... so I was always too nervous," Britcher said last month. "And then I thought, 'You know what? I want to do it. I'm just trying to really enjoy myself and enjoy sliding this year. And I think it'll be fun, even if it turns out terrible.' But it turned out really cool."

Meditation and manifestation are a big part of elite athletes' success. Britcher's sled offers a constant reminder to take a deep breath, to take it easy and to smile.

And hopefully it'll also remind whoever laughed at Gertie Burper to tune into luge runs.

Jake Paul's fiancée sets Olympic speed skating record

MILAN, Italy – Jutta Leerdam is more than Jake Paul's fiancée. Now she's an Olympic gold medal winner.

Leerdam, a 27-year-old speed skater from the Netherlands, won the women's 1,000 meters at the 2026 Winter Olympics on Monday Feb. 9 with a time of 1:12.31, setting an Olympic record in the process.

It came just moments after her teammate Femke Kok had set her own Olympic record with a time of 1:12.59 to give the Dutch a sweep of the top of the podium.

Miho Takagi of Japan took bronze with a time 1:13.95.

American Brittany Bowe just missed out on a medal. Skating against, Kok, Bowe stood in silver medal position until Leerdam and Takagi took the ice.

Leerdam, who won silver in this distance in the 2022 Winter Olympics in Beijing, blistered around the speed skating oval in the final pairing. The only question was whether she could clock a better time than Kok to take the gold from her teammate. Leerdam kept her speed around the final turn to edge her compatriot by the slimmest of margins: 0.28 seconds.

Leerdam has captured six European

championships and seven world championships during her speed skating career.

During the 2025-26 season, she won two out of the first three World Cup events and three out of the first five.

Paul gets emotional watching Leerdam win gold

Paul was in the Milan speed skating stadium to watch his fiancée race and became emotional when she broke the Olympic record and secured the gold medal. USA Network cut to Paul crying in the stands seconds after Leerdam crossed the finish line.

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Casper performs with GB syndrome

CORTINA d'AMPEZZO, Italy – Danny Casper never cries.

He's not the emotional type. He's actually somewhat aloof. He and his curling teammates joke that he's never focused enough to really be thrown off in-game. But looking back on the last two years from atop the Italian Dolomites at his first Winter Olympics, Casper can't help but choke on his words. Can't stop the tears from welling in his eyes. Can't not feel all the feelings.

"I don't want to say I never thought I'd be here, because that's all I thought about every day," he told USA TODAY. "But at the same time, it's like, I did mean it when I said, 'I guess I'll just have to watch my friends there and cheer them on.'"

Curling is Casper's life. He's been doing it for 13 years, since he was one of a very few juniors at the Ardsley Curling Club in New York hanging around on the ice with adults gracious enough to let him tag along. Ask him what he does outside of the sport, and he won't really have an answer for you. ("Yeah, maybe not the healthiest thing," he conceded sarcastically. "Not sure.")

But two years ago he had to give it up. Had to "forget curling" for a little while. A decision his body made for him, because he could no longer walk. "Could not do anything really." That included operating his cell phone, which meant it definitely included picking up and throwing a forty-something-pound curling stone.

Casper developed Guillain-Barré syndrome, or GBS – an autoimmune disease in which the body's immune system attacks the nerves. This can lead to numbness, weakness and paralysis. It took three months for doctors to figure out what was going on with him. He's been living with the diagnosis, which affects one to two people in every 100,000, for two years and counting.

Days are better now than they used to be. He's a skip at the Winter Games after all, having dethroned John Shuster's team at the U.S. Olympic Trials to qualify. But the pain still gets to him. After making it through this four-year cycle, Casper is not sure he could continue into 2030 if he still feels this way then. (The exact cause and cure for GBS is unknown, though most people recover fully. Casper was initially told it'd go away within eight months to a year.)

He's doing his best to take this experience in. He wishes he was better at that sort of thing. "I'm always, like, screwing around during the game and stuff, and I don't think the moment has gotten to me in good and bad ways," Casper said. "I almost would like to be a little bit more, like, 'Wow, I'm here at the Olympics.'"

But there are moments, like the press conference Feb. 10, when he was asked what it meant to be in Cortina after all he'd been through. His voice caught in his throat and his chin quivered as he answered. Competing at the highest level is special. But competing at all?

"At the end of the day, I'm curling," he said. "It's pretty much all I can ask for."

Casper brushed off the first indication something was amiss in 2024. He was competing at the USA Curling Mixed Doubles Nationals. He doesn't usually compete in mixed doubles. And he doesn't usually sweep, which he was doing for partner Vickey Persinger.

Sweeping wasn't one of Casper's strengths. So when he started dealing with neck and back pain at the event, he chalked it up to a skill issue as opposed to a medical one. But over the next two weeks he "went downhill super fast."

Casper bounced from doctor to doctor for three months. They threw a phone book of diagnoses his way. Maybe it's multiple sclerosis, or MS, a disease that "causes breakdown of the protective covering of nerves," according to the Mayo Clinic. MS can cause symptoms including but not limited to numbness, weakness, trouble walking and vision changes.

Maybe it's a vitamin D deficiency. Casper scoffed at the thought. No way a vitamin deficiency was causing all this. Then he Googled it, and understood where they were coming from. ("I think I did a pretty good job of not really Goo-

gling for a while, but had to a little bit," Casper joked. "And then it's like, you know, 'You're dead.'")

So he spent a month taking vitamin D pills. Which did nothing. Great, he thought, another month wasted.

The U.S. Olympic & Paralympic Committee referred him to a doctor through its partnership with the University of Florida hospital system. After reviewing all of Casper's information and giving him an EMG (electromyography) nerve test, he was diagnosed with GBS.

"A lot of people think, oh, I was sick, and I got through it, and now I'm here at the Olympics. Like, 'What a story,' or whatever. It's not over at all."

Casper takes medication for treatment, changing up his regiment every so often to meet his needs. He started with gabapentin, a nerve blocker. Then "a bunch of muscle relaxer stuff." A few months ago he started taking carbamazepine, a medication typically used for seizures.

It's working. For the most part. But Casper didn't want to risk a different cocktail of medications that would make him feel worse at the Olympics. He'll wrap up this season, go home, and see about trying something new this summer.

Once his dexterity started to return, Casper decided to get back into curling. He missed more than half of the 2024-25 season. At nationals last season, Casper and USA Curling alternate Rich Ruohonen, 30 years Casper's senior, de-

cided each skip would play every other game. Basically load management.

Teammates help Casper clean his rocks on the ice if his hands are bothering him in a game, a move he's sure makes other teams view him as some kind of diva or prima donna. He still goes to the gym with them at 6 o'clock most mornings. He focuses on mobility exercises rather than strength training, showing up because he recognizes the importance of just being there.

Together they won Olympic Trials, a shocking feat as every upset is made even more impressive because of how often they had to work with another skip while Casper was away.

"We've got absolutely nothing to lose," he said, though that doesn't take away from the ultimate goal: gold.

One of the hardest parts of living with GBS, Casper said, is that you can't see it. No one can.

He wants others living with invisible autoimmune diseases to know it's OK to lean on people for support. Even if it feels weird or hard.

Just like a curling game. Casper captains the team, but he has to rely on sweepers Aidan Oldenburg and Ben Richardson to guide the rock to the button. Friends, family and teammates are the sweepers in Casper's life. They helped guide him to Cortina for a chance at gilded glory.

This Amended Notice of Plan Approval Hearing amends a previous Notice that you may have received. The only substantive changes in this Amended Notice are (1) a change in the hearing date, and (2) a change in the deadline by which you must file any objections that you might have, each of which dates are set forth below.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE OF THE FOLLOWING: Kaitlin Asrow, the Acting Superintendent of Financial Services of the State of New York (the "Superintendent"), as the court-appointed rehabilitator (the "Rehabilitator") of Columbian Mutual Life Insurance Company ("CML") in the above-captioned rehabilitation proceeding (the "Rehabilitation Proceeding"), hereby notifies you that she has filed a *Plan of Rehabilitation for Columbian Mutual Life Insurance Company*, dated December 12, 2025 (as may be amended, modified or supplemented from time to time, the "Plan").

Pursuant to the Court's amended Plan Scheduling Order entered on February 10, 2026 (the "Amended Plan Scheduling Order"), the hearing at which the Court will consider approval of the Plan will commence on **May 4, 2026, at 10:30 a.m.** (the "Plan Approval Hearing") before the Court located at 92 Court Street, Binghamton, New York 13901. Capitalized terms used but not defined herein shall have the meanings ascribed to them in the Plan.

The Rehabilitator seeks approval of the Plan to remove the causes and conditions that made the Rehabilitation Proceeding necessary. This will be accomplished by a series of transactions ("Transactions") under the Plan for the acquisition of CML by JAB Insurance US Holdings, Inc. (the "Purchaser"), in exchange for the Purchaser making a financial contribution of not less than \$100 million (the "Contribution") to CML and its subsidiary Columbian Life Insurance Company ("CLIC"), which is currently in rehabilitation proceedings in Illinois. The Contribution will be allocated between CML and CLIC, part of which will be in return for the issuance of CML's new capital stock to Purchaser, and will recapitalize both companies and strengthen their balance sheets.

The Plan is focused on protecting CML Policyholders' insurance benefits. Critically, the Plan will not result in the alteration of any insurance benefits or the insurance terms of the Policyholders' policies, such as premiums, coverage and claims. However, if the Plan is not approved and CML is required to convert to a liquidation proceeding, Policyholder insurance benefits could be jeopardized.

Under the Plan, Policyholders' ownership rights and interests and other Equity Interests in CML, which the Rehabilitator believes do not have any value, will be extinguished and discharged, and the Purchaser will become the owner of CML's newly issued capital stock. In addition, the Plan provides certain releases, including the release of the Purchaser and its Affiliates from any Claims in connection with the Transactions, including the extinguishment and discharge of Policyholders' Equity Interests.

In addition, the Plan *will not* impair the rights of creditors, vendors, and other contractual counterparties. All such claims will be processed and paid in the ordinary course of CML's business.

If the Plan is approved by the Court at the Plan Approval Hearing and consummated, CML will emerge as a recapitalized insurance company capable of meeting its policy obligations. Accordingly, the Rehabilitator submits that the Plan is in the best interests of Policyholders and CML's other stakeholders.
