Colombian stunningly wins Cognizant Classic

PALM BEACH GARDENS, FL – Shane Lowry found another way to lose a title at the Cognizant Classic in the Palm Beaches. And Nico Echavarria made true on his prediction of winning.

Lowry had a three-shot lead on the 16th tee on March 1 but made consecutive double bogeys – the first time he’s done that in his PGA Tour career – after woeful iron shots. His miscues handed the victory to Colombia’s Echavarria before a stunned gallery at PGA National.

Lowry’s three-shot lead disappeared on the Champion course after he double-bogeyed 16 and Echavarria, playing in the group ahead, made a 10-foot birdie putt at the difficult 17th. When Lowry’s tee shot at No. 17 landed well short in the water, leading to another double bogey, the tournament was over.

Lowry settled for a second-place finish with Taylor Moore (68) and Austin Smotherman (69). He was looking for his first individual PGA Tour title since the 2019 British Open, though he paired

with Rory McIlroy to win a team event in New Orleans in 2024.

It was Echavarria’s third PGA Tour victory, this one coming in shocking fashion, to earn \$1.728 million and a return trip to the Masters. He led the field in fewest bogeys (four) and was there to pounce when Lowry lost his swing.

“I had some good breaks. To win out

here, sometimes you have to have good breaks if you’re not Scottie Scheffler, who hits it every time in the perfect place,” Echavarria said. “I didn’t think I had a chance when Shane had a three-shot lead, but the Bear Trap played harder today than it had the first three days. It’s unfortunate the way he finished, but it’s a hard tournament to close.”

It was another agonizing finish for Lowry. It was his fourth top-five finish at Cognizant in the last five years, the heartbreaker coming in 2022 when a brief downpour on the 18th hole left Lowry settling for a runner-up finish to Sepp Straka.

Echavarria was 4-under after 10 holes in the final round to take the lead, only to lose it when Lowry eagled the 10th hole. Echavarria made five consecutive pars before the birdie at the 17th gave him the lead and a par at the 18th protected his two-shot lead.

It was an eventful week for Echavarria, who closed on a house in nearby Palm Beach Gardens on Feb. 27. He spent the week staying at fellow

Colombian Camillo Villegas’ house.

“I’ve been through the lowest of lows and this was the highest of highs,” said Echavarria, who missed four cuts in five events on the West Coast. “I’ll remember that shot on 17 for the rest of my life. When I saw it drift right, I lost some weight.

“I told some people I thought I was going to win this week. I had a feeling I was ready to play some good golf.”

Smotherman led after each of the first three rounds but settled for second place. He was trying to win his first PGA Tour title in his 82nd start.

“It was a successful week,” he said.

Nicolai Hojgaard of Denmark tried to match Joe Highsmith’s feat of a year ago, when Highsmith made the cut on the number and shot a pair of 64s to claim his first PGA Tour title. Hogjaard also made the cut on the number Feb. 27, then shot 66 and was 7-under through 11 holes to move within a shot of the lead. He missed a short birdie putt at 12 and three-putted the 13th, however, and finished sixth after a 65. Ricky Castillo (68) finished fifth.

Reddick’s 3-for-3 a first

Tyler Reddick achieved a feat no one else ever has.

For the first time in the 77-year history of NASCAR, a driver has started the season with three straight victories. Reddick held off Shane van Gisbergen and Christopher Bell to win the Dura-max Texas Grand Prix on March 1 at Circuit of the Americas in Austin.

“It means the world,” Reddick said. “Yeah, it’s so fitting. We get going at the end there, and I’m leading and there’s SVG, the guy I’ve been trying to beat for a while now. Just to be able to outlast him there and hold on for the win is just incredible.”

Reddick has 23XI Racing rolling

Reddick’s hot stretch continues.

Not only did he claim the first two checkered flags of the season, he posted the fastest qualifying time Feb. 28 to start the race on the pole.

He then led 58 of the 95 laps. Ryan Blaney (11) was the only other driver to lead more than eight. Reddick’s final margin over SVG was 3.94 seconds.

“Just trying to remember everything that I knew was going to be important there at the end and just tried to minimize the mistakes,” Reddick said. “Shane is – this is what he’s so good at. He does not make mistakes. I certainly made a couple and just doing everything I could to just manage the gap and just stay away from him, if you know what I mean. If I let him get close enough, it was going to be probably hard to hold him off.”

With Reddick’s win, 23XI Racing also became the first team to begin the season with three straight wins since Petty Enterprises in 1963, according to NASCAR Insights. 23XI won once in 2025.

“He kept to his strategy, and man, the guys put together a great car,” co-owner Michael Jordan said.

COTA was the one Cup road course he didn’t prevail at last year, though he won the O’Reilly Series event Feb. 28.

“Yeah, it’s weird to be disappointed with second, but this series is just at a high level,” SVG said. “I felt, OK, we got our SafetyCulture Chevy a lot better than yesterday, but just following Tyler, his driving was immaculate and his car was very good, too. NASCAR schedule update: Phoenix up next

It’s no longer the host of the championship finale, but Phoenix Raceway still represents important stops during the Cup Series slate.

In 2026, the venue retained a playoff race in mid-October, and next weekend, it will mark the first appearance of the season at a bread-and-butter oval track. NASCAR opened with two superspeedways and a road course.

Bell and Blaney won the 2025 events at the 1-mile track. The Straight Talk Wireless 500 will feature 312 laps, which add up to 500 kilometers. The race will air on FS1 at 3:30 p.m. ET March 8.

IndyCar’s Alex Palou makes winning look easy

ST. PETERSBURG, FL – The first race of the 2026 season was truly a battle for second place, much like many NTT IndyCar Series races in 2025. That’s because Alex Palou, who won eight of the 17 races last year, controlled the Grand Prix of St. Petersburg unchallenged on March 1.

Palou won his second consecutive St. Petersburg race by 12.4948 seconds, the largest winning margin in its 23-race history. There were questions about whether he could maintain a similar stranglehold on the sport in 2026, and the early results are promising for the four-time IndyCar champ.

Palou began the race in fourth place after Scott McLaughlin won the pole. Every driver and team entered the race with a crucial tire decision to make. Cars were required to run with two sets of Firestone’s red alternate tires, which are faster and deteriorate more quickly. Each car had to also run with one set of the primary black tires that last longer and are slower.

Palou started with his alternate tires, while McLaughlin and Marcus Ericsson – who began the race in second, on the front row with McLaughlin – began with their primary tires.

The strategy quickly jolted Palou’s No. 10 Chip Ganassi Racing Honda in front of the pack. The Spaniard opened a lead that got above 14 seconds, helping him negate having to switch to the slower tires later.

“I was a little bit surprised by the fuel-saving that the 3 (McLaughlin) and the 28 (Ericsson) were doing at that moment,” Palou said. “Just felt like it was just being more in our favor, especially knowing that Honda always gets a lot better mileage. I was just waiting. I didn’t know if we were going to have enough tires at the end to make it, but yeah, we did. We had a couple of clean laps and that’s what gave us the lead.”

Barry Wanser, Palou’s strategist, said CGR took a “big chance” with its tire management of the No. 10 car, but it got Palou his 20th career IndyCar victory.

“We started on the sticker reds,” Wanser said, “which we knew was a bit of a risk to not save those, the best tires, for the last. But it worked out. Again, I think Alex brought it up, the pace of the leaders at the time in the

early part of the race certainly helped us go the distance.”

McLaughlin finished second and had a strong weekend under rehired Team Penske strategist Tim Cindric. But if he had to do it over again, McLaughlin would’ve started the race with alternate tires like Palou.

“Obviously, I think the correct decision today was probably to start on red tires, but we didn’t know that going in,” McLaughlin said. “It was sort of our gut feel and where we wanted to go, and we decided to go blacks. We didn’t have the pace on them, and (Palou) managed to.”

Wanser said he left it up to Palou to decide which tires he wanted to begin the race with. Palou’s decision turned out to be the right one en route to a seamless victory.

Palou’s success can be attributed to his mistake-free driving. He didn’t win this race due to a climactic pass or a crash in front of him. He won due to the team’s early tire strategy and consistent pace afterward. Palou’s driving doesn’t lead to drama, but that’s why he could win a fourth consecutive championship this year. He doesn’t have an apparent weakness, while the rest of the field has blind spots that leave them behind the No. 10 car.

Since joining Chip Ganassi Racing in 2021, Palou has won 20 of the 85 (23.5%) races he’s driven. Not only has he won three championships in a row, but no one else has led the standings since Will Power on June 9, 2024.

Palou’s historic performance in St. Petersburg proved he’s just as far ahead (if not further ahead) of the field as he was in 2025. If March 1 was any indication of what’s to come, Palou may steamroll his way to another Astor Challenge Cup.

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Bhatia plays boldly to win at Bay Hill

ORLANDO, FL – Akshay Bhatia made a Sunday charge that would have made Arnold Palmer proud.

Five strokes back after missing a short putt at nine on March 8, he reeled off four straight birdies and then delivered the signature shot of the tournament, a cut 6-iron from 191 yards to a tucked flag at the par-5 16th to set up eagle. His caddie, Joe Greiner, gave him one simple instruction: “Try to hit the best 6-iron of your life.”

Bhatia nearly jarred it and tapped in for eagle. Time and again over the closing stretch, Bhatia played boldly and fired at flags, making it only appropriate that the winner of the 2026 Arnold Palmer Invitational is the golfer who went for broke just as Palmer, who died 10 years ago, did in his heyday. Bhatia, 24, rallied to shoot 3-under 69 at Bay Hill Club and Lodge and beat Daniel Berger in a playoff for his third victory.

“Everyone knows when you show up to this tournament how hard it is, an elite field, obviously, and just very honored to win his event,” Bhatia said. “I know he was up there watching and

probably pretty proud of how that finish was for this week.”

Bhatia sprinkled three bogeys on the front nine to fall five strokes behind Berger, who was trying to go wire-to-wire for his first win in five years.

At the ninth, Bhatia missed a putt of less than 3 feet, which he called “a mental mistake,” and Berger holed a 10-foot birdie putt to get to 15 under. That’s

when Bhatia’s anger boiled over as he made the long walk to the 10th tee.

“He said he was so pissed and I told him, ‘Go play the next hole pissed off,’” recounted Greiner. “Then when he made birdie, I said, ‘Go play this one pissed off too.’”

Greiner gave one more piece of wisdom to Bhatia, who he began working with late last year at the Hero World Challenge. Last month, Bhatia built a five-stroke lead at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am but ended up finishing T-6 at the signature event. “I said, ‘Remember how hard it was for you when you had a five-shot lead at Pebble Beach on Saturday? That’s how Daniel feels right now,’” Greiner said.

Bhatia embraced being the chaser. It didn’t hurt Bhatia’s chances that he enjoyed a career week with his long putter, ranking first in the field in strokes gained: putting, and gaining more than 10 strokes on the greens for the week. He also set a new record for the most strokes gained for short game and putting combined in a PGA Tour win in the ShotLink era (plus-16.3), making up for that short miss with a 58-foot bomb at No. 11. After a bogey at 15, he hit one of the shots of the year at the par-5 16th.

With the eagle trimming his deficit to one, Bhatia stayed aggressive, taking dead aim with an 8-iron at 17 that stopped 18 feet from the hole.

Bhatia went flag-hunting again with a 9-iron at 18 that barely cleared the lake. Nevertheless, he nearly won it in regulation except Berger drained a clutch 14-foot par putt to post 70. Knetted at 15-under 273, they returned to 18 for the first playoff at Arnie’s Place since 1999.

It’s the biggest victory for Bhatia, 24, who first won an opposite-field event in 2023, then a full-field event in 2024 and now a signature event. He’s won all three times in playoffs.

Shortly after he slipped into the famed red alpaca sweater awarded to the winner, a rainbow popped out in the sky and it made Bhatia think of his sister’s 5-year-old daughter, Mia, who was in the Bahamas to attend his wedding in December and died that day of a rare disease.

“I had my niece definitely watching over me,” Bhatia said. “When I saw that rainbow on 18, it reminded me of her ... I’ve been thinking about her for a long time after she passed, and dedicate this win for her.”

Zach Johnson wins Champions debut

Make it 1-for-1 for Zach Johnson. The 12-time PGA Tour winner and two-time major champion won his first PGA Tour Champions title in his first time out.

Johnson won the 2026 James Hardie Pro Football Hall of Fame Invitational at The Old Course at Broken Sound Club in Boca Raton, Florida, by four shots over Stewart Cink and George McNeill. Johnson was the lone golfer to get to double-digits under par, finishing at 11 under after his final-round 69. Padraig Harrington had the round of the day March 8 with a 7-under 65. He tied for fourth at 6 under.

Johnson is the 22nd golfer to win his Champions tour debut and first since Richard Bland in 2024.

Johnson led by a shot after 36 holes after he posted a bogey-free 66 in the second round. He made his Champions debut just a few weeks after turning 50 on Feb. 24.

“I am invigorated to go out there and, you know, not take a head cover off on a par 4,” Johnson joked ahead of the tournament week. “I’m not taking it for

granted. I feel like I’ve earned my diploma, and I’m gonna make the jump to greener pastures, more or less.”

After closing out the win, he said: “It’s humbling, it’s humbling just to get to this point. I mean, you were talking about it, George [McNeill] and I, even Tom Gillis, that was a good buddy of mine on his bag, I mean if you would have told me I’d be here at 50 years old, you know, the hypothetical part of that is so incredible that I would have said you’re crazy. Staying in modest shape to play with these guys because it’s still really good golf, highly competitive on a phenomenal track, I am humbled. I am extremely excited, and I have been excited. The first moment I stepped foot on this premises, I was like, hey, this is special. So well done. The guys have been amazing.”

Johnson said he expects to play a full Champions tour schedule in 2026 in addition to “maybe three” events on the PGA Tour. The 2007 Masters champ will also return to Augusta National next month for the major.

Castillo earns 1st PGA victory in Puerto Rico

The Puerto Rico Open featured a field chock full of up-and-comers. That included Ricky Castillo, whose game seems to be coming together.

A week ago, he finished solo fifth at the Cognizant Classic. This week, Castillo, 25, became a PGA Tour event champion, winning in Puerto Rico after a final-round 5-under 67 March 8. His \$720,000 first-place prize, coupled with the \$500,000 he’s banked already, sends him over the \$1 million mark on the season.

And, his PRO win gets him into the 2026 Players Championship next week and the 2026 PGA Championship. The only other major he’s played in was the 2020 U.S. Open.

Castillo shot 68-68-68 over his first three days but was saving his best for last with that Sunday 67 to win by a shot over Chandler Blanchet.

Castillo opened with five straight pars and then eagled the sixth and birdied the seventh.

He had two more birdies on Nos. 13 and 14 and kept his card bogey-free,

closing with a par on the 18th.

“I really just stayed focused and just did what I’ve been trying to do for the past six or seven months. Just really work hard on my mental and emotional game and that’s been a really huge thing for me,” said Castillo.

Blades Brown was solo third at 14 under. Davis Thompson was solo fourth at 13 under.

Brown, 18, was angling to become the youngest winner on the PGA Tour in nearly 100 years but he got derailed with a triple-bogey 7 on the 13th hole. He was 5 under on his round and 16 under overall) prior to that.

Blanchet shot 64-67 before ballooning with a 74 in the third round. His final-round 67 got him to 16 under but one stroke shy of forcing a playoff with Castillo.

John Daly II, one of two amateurs to make the cut, finished tied for 37th after a final-round 74.

The Puerto Rico open is one of four opposite-field tournaments on the PGA Tour.

Ryan Blaney perseveres to win Cup race at Phoenix

The Straight Talk Wireless 500 ended after 312 laps as scheduled. It avoided overtime despite tying a Phoenix Raceway record with 12 caution flags.

That was good news for Ryan Blaney. He crossed the finish line 0.399 seconds before Christopher Bell, who led a race-high 176 laps and was making a late charge, to lock down his first victory of the 2026 NASCAR Cup Series season March 8.

“Obviously, the 20 was the best car,”

Blaney said. “I don’t know how many more laps I could have held them off. We were able to do that.”

Blaney grabbed the lead with 10 laps to go. He recovered from multiple early setbacks to front the pack for 28 trips around the track, which trailed only Bell and Joey Logano (73 laps led).

“Just perseverance,” Blaney said. “I mean, everybody on the 12 group persevered all day. We had a couple mistakes that we learned from, got better, had to come from the back a couple times.”

His victory also slashed Tyler Reddick’s three-race winning streak to kick off the campaign.

Ryan Blaney moves into top 50 on NASCAR all-time wins list

With his 18th career victory, Blaney now ranks inside the top 50 in Cup Series history. The 32-year-old Team Penske driver tied Geoff Bodine, Neil Bonnett, Harry Gant, Kasey Kahne and Ryan Newman for 49th all-time.

“It’s neat,” Blaney said. “I didn’t know that, that I tied those guys. Big fan of those guys ... Just happy to be part of a group like that.”

Blaney sits second in the points standings with three top-10 finishes in four weeks.

Tyler Reddick still leads standings

Yes, Reddick’s winning streak came to a close. But it wasn’t all bad.

The driver of the 23XI Racing’s No. 45 Toyota still resides in first place in the standings. He’s the only driver to notch a top-10 finish in all four races after slotting eighth at Phoenix.

“All in all, it would have been nice to make it four,” Reddick said. “Looking at the board over here, scored the fourth-most amount of points on the day. That’s kind of what we need to keep doing all year to keep the lead that we have and try and hang on to it.”
