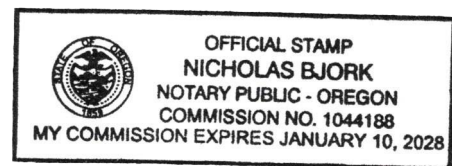

Elliott puts Hendrick in win column

NASCAR’s trip to Martinsville Speed- way came at a good time for Hendrick Motorsports.

No, the constant contender had not turned to rubbish in the last two months, but it had not captured a NAS- CAR Cup Series victory through the first six weeks of 2026. That served as their longest winless streak to open a season since 2019.

If there was ever a perfect place to change that, it was the historic speed- way in Ridgeway, Virginia, though.

Chase Elliott grabbed the checkers in the Cook Out 400 on March 29. The win marked Hendrick’s 31st on the 0.526- mile oval, the most of any organization at any track in the sport.

Elliott led 84 laps. He held off Denny Hamlin, who dominated the first two stages before settling into the runner- up spot.

Elliott’s victory doubled as an anni- versary gift. He debuted in the Cup Se- ries on the same day at the same track 11 years ago. Now in his 11th full-time cam- paign, Elliott carries 22 career wins,

including two at Martinsville. “It’s really cool when this stuff works out, and to win these races is so tough,” he said. “Just really grateful for the

opportunity as always. I never take it for granted, trust me. It’s a dream come true for me.” It required some smart moves by

Elliott and a dash of luck. Alan Gustafson, the crew chief for the No. 9 Chevrolet, called for Elliott to short pit on lap 261. The strategy panned out for the duo when a caution flag on lap 312 allowed Elliott to pit again from second and remain up front. “We took a gamble,” Elliott said. “We were going to two-stop that last stage. I honestly think it was going to work out really good for us either way. Just so proud of them, man.” Hamlin looked to be doing it again. In 2025, he commanded the spring race at Martinsville, pacing everyone for 274 laps on his way to victory lane. He surpassed that total this go-round with 292 laps led. He also laid down the fastest qualifying time March 28 and snatched two stage wins in the race. It was Hamlin at his best. But following the final caution, Elliott wrestled away the lead, and Hamlin spent the rest of the race in unsuccess- ful pursuit. “He did a good job controlling the pace there,” Hamlin said. “It really came from that bad restart I had besides (Ross Chastain). Just not much really I could’ve done there, and it felt like we gave it our all.”

Palou wins as pit stop error costs Lundgaard

LEEDS, AL – A glance at the final re- sults makes it seem like Alex Palou was unchallenged in his 13.3-second victory in IndyCar’s Children’s of Alabama Indy Grand Prix. But Palou’s winning margin is a bit misleading.

As Palou pitted for the last time at Barber Motorsports Park, Arrow McLa- ren’s Christian Lundgaard took the race lead for the second time. When Palou exited pit lane, his No. 10 Chip Ganassi Racing Honda was stuck behind the traffic of Mick Schumacher and Dennis Hauger, who were at the tail end of the lead lap.

Lundgaard managed to further his lead while Palou navigated past Schu- macher and Hauger. When Lundgaard entered his final pit stop four laps later, on lap 69, it appeared he’d end up in a battle to defeat the four-time NTT Indy- Car Series champion.

But Arrow McLaren’s pit crew had an issue securely putting the rear right tire on the No. 7 Chevrolet, causing the pit stop to take nearly 18 seconds. The blun- der essentially ended Lundgaard’s chance to win, allowing Palou to cruise through the last 22 laps with the lead.

“We had the car to win the race,” Lundgaard said. “We had the pace, we had the track position at the time. I’m not really sure what happened in the pit stop. I’m not sure I can really comment too much on it. Again, it’s unfortunate.”

Kyle Moyer, Lundgaard’s strategist at Arrow McLaren, told IndyStar that “it happens” and “we win as a team and lose as a team.”

Even after the elongated pit stop, Lundgaard passed Rahal Letterman Lanigan’s Graham Rahal on lap 88 of 90 to finish second.

Lundgaard feels it would’ve been a “fair and square fight” with Palou for the

win had the error not occurred. “We finished P2, we shouldn’t be that frustrated,” he said. “But when you are up against a car that’s been the most competitive and best car in IndyCar for the past many years, to have a chance to beat him fair and square, that hurts. It’s the position that we’ve tried to be in the past three years. “I think we got there today. Really, just to miss out on it for something like that is unfortunate. I think there’s a lot of learning to take from it.” Lundgaard is in his second season with Arrow McLaren, and he’s search- ing for his first win with the team after getting his lone career victory in 2023 with Rahal Letterman Lanigan. Lund- gaard has now finished on the podium eight times since joining Arrow McLa- ren. In Lundgaard’s nine podium finishes in the last three seasons, the Danish

driver has finished behind Palou eight times, including in last year’s Children’s of Alabama Indy Grand Prix. Lundgaard has repeatedly suffered from Palou’s greatness. “Every time I’m on the podium, sec- ond or third, he’s first,” Lundgaard said earlier this month, when Palou won the Grand Prix of St. Petersburg while he finished third. “It’s pretty annoying.” In St. Petersburg, Florida, Palou was truly unchallenged, unlike at Barber. This could’ve been Lundgaard’s shot to finally beat Palou, yet it ended up being déjà vu. “I feel like it would have been a very close battle and maybe would have been a race that Lundgaard could have won,” Palou said. “If you look at the result and you don’t follow the race, the timings, maybe then you look like you were so much faster than everybody else. That was not the truth.”

Lundgaard moved from seventh to third in IndyCar’s points standings, but he remains behind Palou (second) and Kyle Kirkwood (first). The 24-year-old is still in search of a significant break- through moment, despite a career-best fifth-place finish in 2025. Mishaps like the one that knocked Lundgaard out of contention are the reason Palou remains the standard in IndyCar. Just like in St. Petersburg, Pa- lou didn’t need a remarkable late lap pass to win this race. He and the CGR team just managed not to slip up, and Palou patiently made his way back to the lead after Lundgaard gained ground on him. As Lundgaard knows all too well, it takes a nearly flawless race to outdo Pa- lou. One minor mistake can completely alter the race, as it did on Sunday. Zion Brown is IndyStar’s motorsports reporter. 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COLLEGE WOMEN’S BASKETBALL TRANSFER PORTAL RANKINGS

UCLA on lookout for replacing six seniors

The transfer portal for college women’s basketball opened April 6.

This is a change from last season, when the portal opened for 30 days after the second round of the Women’s NCAA Tournament. The transfer window is also shorter this year, open for 15 days.

As coaches predicted, moving and shortening the window will neither stop players from announcing their intentions to enter the portal, nor stop their agents from communicating with teams.

“I have several transfers on my team now, but I’m also going to lose six seniors,” UCLA coach Cori Close said. “We’re going to be very proactive in the transfer portal. We’re probably going to sign five transfers.”

Last season saw several stars of women’s basketball transfer. Olivia Miles went from Notre Dame to TCU, Malaysia Fulwiley from South Carolina to LSU, Ta’Niya Latson from South Carolina to Florida State and Cotie McMahon from Ohio State to Ole Miss.

The top 20 players who have entered the portal.

1. Audi Crooks, Iowa State

A two-time All-American and three-time All-Big 12 selection, Crooks is easily the most talented scorer in the portal so far. She led the nation in scoring this season with 25.8 points per game and also averaged 7.7 rebounds and 1.7 assists per game. Despite her individual accomplishments, Crooks never played in the second weekend of the NCAA Tournament with Iowa State.

2. Talaysia Cooper, Tennessee

The 6-foot guard from South Carolina has one year of eligibility left after spending two seasons with Kim Caldwell’s Lady Vols. Cooper led Tennessee in scoring this season with 16.1 points per game and shot a career-best 34.3% from 3-point land. She’s a two-time All-SEC selection.

3. Jada Williams, Iowa State

Williams has one year of eligibility left after spending two seasons at Arizona and this last year at Iowa State. With the Cyclones, she ranked third nationally in assists per game with 7.7 and also posted 15.3 points per game.

4. Addy Brown, Iowa State

The versatile junior forward will spend her senior season elsewhere after three years with the Cyclones. A two-time All-Big 12 selection, Brown averages 13.6 points, 8.1 rebounds and 5.2 assists while shooting 36.7% from 3-point land for her career.

5. Zam Jones, NC State

The sophomore guard was promoted to a starting role this season at NC State. A volume shooter, she showed the ability to score in bunches for the Wolfpack against marquee opponents, dropping 30 points in a first-round NCAA Tournament win over Tennessee and scoring 26 points in a road overtime loss at Oklahoma.

6. Kiyomi McMiller, Penn State

A Jordan Brand and McDonald’s All-American as a high school prospect, McMiller will play for her third school in as many seasons after spending her sophomore campaign with the Nittany Lions. She was 12th nationally in scoring this year with 21.6 points per game. The 5-foot-8 guard began her career at Rutgers.

7. Madison St. Rose, Princeton

A two-time All-Ivy selection, St. Rose has one year of eligibility remaining after averaging 15.8 points, 4.5 rebounds and 2.2 assists in her final season at Princeton.

8. Lanie Grant, North Carolina

One of the youngest sophomores in the country, Grant reclassified to join the Tar Heels a year early. She’s with Team USA at the youth level, was 2024 Virginia High School Player of the Year and an ESPN top 100 recruit. Grant emerged as a starter for the Tar Heels this season and averaged 10.8 points and 2.3 assists per game. She shot 41.9% from 3-point land, which ranked 21st nationally.

9. Taryn Barbot, Charleston

The junior guard led the Cougars to their first NCAA Tournament appearance this season and scored 36 points against Duke in Cameron Indoor Stadium in a first-round loss. She ranked 17th nationally in scoring this season with 20.1 points per game. Barbot was twice named CAA Player of the Year.

10. Achol Akot, Oklahoma State

The 6-foot-1 Canadian forward was third in scoring and first in rebounding for the Cowgirls this season with 12.4 points and 7.2 rebounds per game. Her 63.3% shooting clip from the floor ranked sixth nationally and she was ninth in points per scoring attempt with a mark of 1.31.

11. Filipa Barros, Cal Baptist

The MVP of the WAC tournament, Barros was the bus driver for the Lancers as they made the NCAA Tournament for the second time in program history. The 5-foot-9 redshirt junior guard from Portugal was the only player in the nation to average at least 10.5 points, 9.5 rebounds and 4.5 assists per game while shooting better than 40% from 3-point land.

12. Naomi White, Northern Arizona

The Big Sky Rookie of the Year, White led the conference in scoring with 20.8 points per game, which also ranked 15th nationally. She also led the Big Sky in minutes played and 3-point shooting at a 36.5% clip.

13. Jadyn Wooten, Oklahoma State

The sophomore guard averaged 12.8 points and 5.4 assists per game off the bench for the Cowgirls this season. She ranked 10th nationally in assists per

40 minutes with 7.7. Wooten made the All-Big 12 Freshman Team last season.

14. Shannon Dowell, Missouri

A former All-Missouri Valley Conference selection at Illinois State and averaged 14.9 points, 6.1 rebounds and 2.3 assists for the Tigers this season.

15. Milan Brown, Wake Forest

An All-ACC freshman team selection, Brown – a native of Baltimore – did a little bit of everything for the Demon Deacons, averaging 9.1 points, 6.3 rebounds, 2.6 assists and 1.1 steals per game while shooting 42.1% from 3-point land. She is a published author and scored more than 2,000 points in high school.

16. Vanessa Harris, Rhode Island

The 5-foot-10 guard from Maryland was voted the Sixth Player of the Year in the Atlantic 10 after averaging 10.2 points, 3.8 rebounds and 1.1 assists per game as a freshman.

17. Sophie Burrows, Syracuse

The 6-foot-2 guard from Australia has one year of eligibility left after spending three seasons with the Orange. Burrows shot 39% from 3-point land last season as a sophomore and this year averaged 11.1 points per game.

18. Amari Whiting, Oklahoma State

The 5-foot-10 junior guard from Idaho will transfer for the second time in her collegiate career after averaging 9.6 points, 5.9 rebounds and 2.6 assists per game for the Cowgirls this season. Whiting previously played two seasons at BYU and shoots 40% from the floor for her career.

19. Solé Williams, Florida State

The 5-foot-9 guard from Ohio averaged 15.1 points, 3.8 rebounds and 3.1 assists per game from the Seminoles.

20. Jaylah Lampley, Mississippi State

Ranked as the 37th recruit by ESPN in the 2025 class, Lampley averaged 8.3 points and 4.7 rebounds for the Bulldogs this season. She shot 50% from the floor and 37% from 3-point land.
