20. Cowboys (from Green Bay Packers) – CB Chris Johnson, San Diego State

This is currently slotted as Dallas’ last pick until the Cowboys resurface at No. 92. A team in need of corner help would have to sift through some checkered options here – though Johnson, the Mountain West Conference’s co-Defensive Player of the Year, whose stock has been surging in recent months, looks pretty clean and pretty promising as a long-term fix. DaRon Bland currently is the only corner with a long-term future on what will be a reimagined Dallas D in 2026 – Cobie Durant signing for just one year.

21. Pittsburgh Steelers – WR KC Concepcion, Texas A&M

He’d nicely thread the needle of being an immediately helpful asset to presumed QBI Aaron Rodgers while also being a long-term building block for an organization that refuses to embrace a full-on reboot. Concepcion would slide right into the slot here between outside behemoth receivers DK Metcalf and Michael Pittman Jr. and would provide plenty of juice both as a run-after-catch demon and a punt returner.

22. LA Chargers – S Emmanuel McNeil-Warren, Toledo

The Bolts have a few areas to address but certainly need to get younger and better on the back line – particularly when Derwin James is deployed as a nickel. A 6-foot-4, 200-pound DB with a penchant for big hits and finding the ball seems like a good fit for a team that also prizes physicality.

23. Philadelphia Eagles – WR Denzel Boston, Washington

Maybe EVP/GM Howie Roseman opts for a pass rusher or a successor to RT Lane Johnson, who will be 36 in May. Either position would be on brand in Philly. But the 2026 season is also shap-

ing up as the latest prove-it year for QB Jalen Hurts, whose deteriorated relationship with WR A.J. Brown has signaled the latter’s departure later this spring, when Brown’s contract becomes easier to trade from a salary cap perspective. Boston (6-foot-4, 212 pounds) is the kind of supersized red-zone target (20 TD catches since 2024) and boundary receiver who could provide an easy transition from Brown while giving Hurts quite a margin for error on 50-50 balls. Boston would also nicely complement the skill sets of DeVonta Smith and recently acquired Dontayvion Wicks.

24. Browns (from Jacksonville Jaguars) – CB Jermod McCoy, Tennessee

So this scenario has unfolded in such a way to suggest that maybe Cleveland needs to strongly consider taking a wideout at No. 6 and wait until here to see what’s available from an offensive line perspective. But, at this point, better to reevaluate the receivers at No. 39 and go best available. And McCoy could be a steal at this spot – especially for a team that’s in more of a long-term planning phase and doesn’t need to rush him as his recovery from a torn ACL that cost him the 2025 season continues. The 4.37 40-yard dash he ran at the Vols’ pro day was a great sign he’s on track, if not all the way back – though McCoy was practicing by the end of his final year in Knoxville.

25. Chicago Bears – OT Kadyn Proctor, Alabama

Proctor’s performance at the Tide’s pro day, when he was clearly in optimal shape, helped showcase the kind of player and athlete he can be – which is to say one who could very nicely safeguard QB Caleb Williams ... and maybe catch a pass or two in the red zone given coach Ben Johnson’s propensity for gadget plays. And, at a time when Chicago is facing patchwork options at left tackle after Ozzy Trapilo ruptured his patellar tendon in the playoffs, why not solidify the spot for the long term with a player who has so much potential.

26. Buffalo Bills – DE Keldric Faulk, Auburn

An intriguing gem in need of some polish, Faulk can bolster an area of concern given the Bills’ wideout issue seems solved by the trade for DJ Moore. Faulk should be a three-down player who can kick inside on passing downs. He also has a reputation as being an excellent locker-room presence.

27. San Francisco 49ers – DE Malachi Lawrence, Central Florida

A team that’s typically at its best when rolling deep on the D-line – but had a league-low 20 sacks in 2025 – adds depth off the edge with a player who has 19 ½ sacks over the last three years and could be even more productive as a pro.

28. Cardinals [Proposed trade from Houston Texans] – QB Ty Simpson, Alabama

Could Arizona be the team that comes up for the highly scrutinized ’Bama quarterback, though Simpson is still widely regarded as this draft’s clear-cut No. 2 passer? It could make sense given veteran Jacoby Brissett remains in place as an ideal bridge option, and the weapons are fairly plentiful when you’ve got the league’s best receiving tight end (Trey McBride) and a solid group of backs and receivers – and that’s potentially an understatement if Marvin Harrison Jr. blossoms. And for anyone infatuated with the sterling tape Simpson compiled – in the first part of last season anyway – he could be a steal, especially at a time when clubs are more comfortable pivoting from Round 1 QBs anyway. Though Simpson only started for one season, he did throw (473) and complete (305) more passes than anyone in the SEC last year.

Maybe the Cards need to jump the Jets at No. 33 and maybe not. But coming up here from No. 34 probably only costs GM Monti Ossenfort a fourth-rounder while also conferring the fifth-year option that comes with being a first-rounder.

29. Chiefs (from Rams) – OT Max Iheanachor, Arizona State

A spectacular, strong, promising prospect – if one who’s fairly new to football the past few years after growing up in Nigeria – Iheanachor could be the guy to better safeguard Mahomes into the future after he was too often running for his life in 2025 ... until he wasn’t.

30. Dolphins (from Denver Broncos) – OT Blake Miller, Clemson

With Lemon already on the way in this scenario, Miami’s next move – with the pick obtained for Waddle – could and should be bolstering the protection around Willis. Miller, an All-ACC right tackle, might be too good to pass up – especially with Dolphins RT Austin Jackson, who’s never truly asserted himself at the NFL level, entering the final year of his contract.

31. New England Patriots – OT Caleb Lomu, Utah

The obvious issue for the AFC champs during the playoffs was protecting QB Drake Maye, who was sacked 21 times in four postseason games, including six times by Seattle in Super Bowl 60. RT Morgan Moses is under contract for two more years but just turned 35. A two-year starter at left tackle for the Utes, Lomu will need to get a little stronger in the NFL. But he might not need very long to displace Moses opposite LT Will Campbell.

32. Seattle Seahawks – RB Jadarian Price, Notre Dame

While they would have liked to retain Super Bowl MVP Kenneth Walker III, other priorities – like re-signing WR/KR Rashid Shaheed – took precedence. But Seattle doesn’t have the luxury of standing pat in the run game, , given RB2 Zach Charbonnet tore his ACL in January. Price is a slasher who starred in a timeshare with Love and could nicely fill Walker’s role – maybe one of Shaheed’s, too, if the Seahawks opt to make him a bigger part of the offense in 2026.

On January 7, 2026, OpenLoop Health, Inc. (“OpenLoop”) learned that an unauthorized third party had gained access to certain OpenLoop systems and removed certain information. Upon discovery, OpenLoop launched an investigation with the assistance of external cybersecurity specialists and in coordination with federal law enforcement, to determine the nature and scope of the incident and to confirm that the unauthorized access had been terminated. Through this investigation, OpenLoop determined that the unauthorized access occurred from January 7 to January 8, 2026. 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Fitzpatrick brothers make Zurich history

Alex and Matt Fitzpatrick do some of their best work as a pair.

When Alex was 14 years old, he cad-died for his brother, Matthew, 17, at the time, at the 2013 U.S. Amateur. Alex still remembers the prize that he received for big bro winning the Havemeyer Trophy.

“My goal for the week was winning an iPhone off my dad, who promised me, if we won the tournament,” Alex recalled. “Obviously he never expected (us) to.”

He got something much better for teaming with his brother to win the Zurich Classic at New Orleans on April 26 – a two-year exemption on the PGA Tour.

Asked if he would accept membership, Alex smiled and said, “I am, indeed, yeah, yeah. I signed as quick as I could. I’m still shaking.”

The Fitzpatricks combined to make birdie in the foursome format at the par-5 18th to shoot 1-under 71 at TPC Louisiana in the Crescent City suburb of Avondale to edge Alex Smalley and Hayden Springer and Kristoffer Reitan and Kris Ventura by one stroke and become the first brothers and family members to win the title. Matt, who won for the third time in his last five starts, became the first player in over two years to win in back-to-back events.

Matt splashed out of the front green-side bunker at 18 and spun it to a foot and Alex tapped in the birdie putt to secure the win with a 72-hole total of 31-under 257.

“I got to the ball, and the lie was unbelievable. I couldn’t have placed it on a better tee,” Matt said of the bunker shot. “I played it to perfection. What more can I say?”

The Englishmen built a four-stroke lead entering the final round after a 57 on April 25 set a tournament-low 18-hole score in the Four-Ball format since 2017. Matt said he didn’t realize until their post-round press conference they had made birdie at the last five holes.

It looked as if the brothers Fitzpatrick would coast to victory in the Big Easy but closing on Sundays on the PGA Tour is rarely a walk in the park. They made three birdies in the first 11 holes but it began unraveling when Matt drove right and behind a tree at 12. Alex’s punch shot ricocheted off a tree and it cost them dearly – their first double bogey of the week. They escaped with par at 13 after a poor approach shot by Matt thanks to Alex floating a world-class lob shot to tap-in range. However, they weren’t so lucky at the par-3 14th, where Matt’s tee shot into another bunker resulted in bogey, and their lead was gone.

“You wonder who is feeling more nervous now,” said Daniel Chopra, an analyst on PGA Tour Radio. “Is it Matt playing for his brother or Alex trying to get his first win on the PGA Tour?”

Matt said he felt as if he had lost his swing, but as he walked up the 15th hole, his father, Russ, stood along the right side of the rope line and egged on his oldest son to “keep going.”

“That was really nice,” recalled Matt, who nailed a clutch 8-foot par putt. “That was a really nice moment for me personally.”

Alex wasn’t the only one seeking his first PGA Tour title. Smalley and Springer, both 29, bogeyed the first and sixth but sprinkled six birdies on the card through the first 16 holes to tie for the lead. There was a Norwegian team sharing the same first name and trying to steal the trophy, too. At 18, Reitan, 28, drilled a fairway wood from 232 yards that rolled to 7 feet and Ventura, 31, buried it to close out a 7-under 65. It was their third eagle of the day, offset by two back-nine bogeys, and allowed them to be first to post 30-under 258.

Moments later, Springer gunned his 44-foot birdie putt 10 feet past the hole at 17 and Smalley missed the comeback-er. But they carded a birdie at the last to finish off a 4-under 68 and match the Norwegians.

Alex never wavered in his belief that his brother, the third-ranked golfer in

the world, would rediscover his mojo. He watched from the gallery this time when Matt returned nearly a decade after winning the U.S. Amateur at The Country Club and won the 2022 U.S. Open there in storybook fashion. When the Fitzpatrick brothers first played in the PGA Tour’s lone team event in 2023, Matt described he and Alex, who played at Wake Forest University and was a two-time member of the Great Britain & Ireland Walker Cup team, as close despite being polar opposites.

“I’m organized, he’s unorganized. He’s happy, I’m miserable,” Matt said. “Yeah, that’s probably a good way to put it really.”

After his bunker shot spun to a stop by the hole at 18 to set up the winning putt, Matt put his arm around Alex just as he had all those times when they were growing up at Hallamshire Golf Club, their home golf club in Sheffield.

The Fitzpatricks became the 13th set of brothers to each have a victory on the PGA Tour and the first to do so in the last 20 years. Other brothers of recent vintage who have played in the pro ranks include Brooks and Chase Koepka, Nick and Curtis Thompson, whose sister Lexi has been the most successful of the bunch, and British Open winner Francesco Molinari and brother Eduardo, who were Ryder Cup teammates.

“To win a team event on the PGA Tour with my brother, I don’t know if it does get better than that,” said Matt, who claimed his fifth PGA Tour title.

Alex secured his first win on the DP World Tour at the Hero Indian Open just one week after Matt’s victory at the Val-spar Championship last month. Now they are both PGA Tour winners, and for Alex it means exemptions into this week’s Cadillac Championship, three remaining signature events this season, the 2026 PGA Championship, and the 2027 Players Championship.

“I couldn’t feel my hands; I couldn’t feel my legs; I couldn’t feel anything,” Alex said. “It’s a pretty life-changing thing.”

Nelly Korda cruises to third LPGA major title

HOUSTON – Nelly Korda wanted to send a message at the Chevron Championship, to herself and to everyone looking up to her: It’s OK to miss short putts.

“You’re going to make mistakes,” said Korda. “You have to mentally still be in it 100%, and that’s really what I wanted to show. I wanted to show it to myself, and I wanted to show it to everyone looking up to me.”

The truth of the matter is that Korda putted beautifully throughout the week. Sure there were miscues, but she won the mental war. Korda credited work with new putting coach David Angelotti for giving structure to her putting practice and an overall sense of calmness.

“He’s a no-nonsense guy, black and white,” said Jason McDede of Angelotti’s style. “There’s no cheerleading involved.”

Korda took control at Memorial Park on Day 1 and never relented, building her lead to as many as eight as she set or matched scoring records throughout the week. In the final round April 26, the lead never dipped lower than four strokes. She ultimately won by five at 18 under, with major champions Patty Tavatanakit and Ruoning Yin taking a share of second.

After a weather-shortened victory to start the season at the Hilton Grand Vacations Tournament of Champions, Korda took a six-week break from competition and came back to finish runner-up three times.

“She played incredible through all the crap that people have talked about her not being able to finish the last couple

weeks or always finishing second,” said older sister Jessica Korda. “She completely put it out of her mind and stuck to her own game and kind of showed everybody, like, stuff you. We always love that.”

Korda, 27, became the first American since Meg Mallon in 2000 to win a third major championship title. Since 1990, only Betsy King, Patty Sheehan and Mallon have managed to win three majors. Korda makes it four.

Now a 17-time winner on the LPGA, becomes the sixth American player to have won a major before the age of 28, joining Patty Berg, Louise Suggs, Betsy Rawls, Mickey Wright, Kathy Whitworth and Amy Alcott.

“It’s not easy being young out here,” said Jessica, winner of six LPGA titles. “I mean, in your early 20s, you’re trying to figure yourself out, at the same time, being an American, everyone’s kind of stripping you down, and every single part of your game, and it’s hard not to listen to the noise sometimes. I think you see Americans come through a little bit later on in their career to win a lot of tournaments, too.”

While Korda opened with back-to-back 65s to set a new 36-hole scoring record, her father, Petr, was more impressed by the two 70s she shot over the weekend, praising the way she handled the pressure.

Korda went into the final round with a five-shot lead and worked hard to protect it, changing her strategy to the point it felt uncomfortable. It worked.

“It’s not easy going in with that big of a lead,” said Korda. “I think that you have almost like a bigger target because maybe girls are like, we have nothing to

lose so we’re going to go after everything.

“For me I’m like having to play defensive at some point but also not wanting to get too defensive because I want to play my own game. That’s where I struggled this weekend of, OK, I wanted to be aggressive on this hole, but if I make a big mistake, I mean, that cuts my lead.

“So having to kind of adjust with that mindset, I think that’s what was really tough. I’m not a player that loves to play defensive.”

There’s no doubt that Korda’s scheduling played a key role in how the week unfolded. She opted to skip last week’s event in Los Angeles to get in earlier and an avoid an awkward Sunday red-eye. Instead, Korda played an early 18 holes on April 20 and got her first look at Memorial Park before storms interrupted

practice the next two days. She was refreshed after a two-week break and hungry to get over the finish line.

Throughout the week in Houston, Korda talked about her mental outlook, how happy she felt in her personal life and with her team. The maturation process, she said on April 26, was a big reason why she finished the day sitting on a dais next to the trophy.

“Last year was definitely a super frustrating year. You know, everyone was talking about my stats,” she said. “I would come into a room like this and everyone would be like, you know, your stats are great, better than last year, but you have zero trophies under your name this year.

“I’m like, I see that, yes. “It just wears on you because that’s what you’re working for. ... You’re like, OK, I don’t want to reinvent the wheel. I don’t want to do anything crazy. But I do want to get better. So what am I going to do better? The first thing was I was getting frustrated last year on the golf course and I started overanalyzing everything and I started overthinking, and then that was paralyzing me.

“I told myself I don’t ever want to feel like that on a golf course.”

She found there’s power in letting go. When it came time for the traditional champion’s leap, Korda took on the plunge pool with her team – including young nephew Greyson – with a masterful cannonball.

“Everyone is going to have their own opinion,” said Korda. “My opinion is if you kill a tradition, it’s going to be gone forever.”

With Korda, it carries on.
