

DePodesta dishes on MLB return 'challenge'

LAS VEGAS – The shock is starting to wear off, but the disbelief is still permeating The Cosmopolitan of Las Vegas hotel Tuesday night Nov. 11 like cigarette smoke hovering in the air at the craps games and poker tables.

There he was, 10 years after he last set foot at the Major League Baseball General Manager meetings, in a room with peers having heard of him but precious few knowing him.

Paul DePodesta, who spent the past 10 years with the NFL's Cleveland Browns, was holding court with the national media for the first time, with everyone having the same question:

What in the world is he doing here as the new president of baseball operations for the Colorado Rockies?

There wasn't a single GM who called DePodesta's hire an "insult," like former manager Joe Maddon said about the San Francisco Giants' hiring of college coach Tony Vitello to be their manager, but still, no one had an answer.

Hiring DePodesta, 52, isn't like hiring a reliever who retired two years ago to manage, like in San Diego, or a 33-year-old getting a managerial job in Washington. He had 20 years of MLB experience and was once the GM of the Los Angeles Dodgers.

Still, when you're away from the game for a decade and are wearing a headset and studying a clipboard on Sundays, folks are curious.

"I can't wait to talk to him," said Alex Anthopoulos, Atlanta's president of baseball operations. "I'd love to hear about his experience in the NFL."

The only National League GMs even around when DePodesta departed the New York Mets for the NFL were A.J. Preller of the San Diego Padres and Andrew Friedman of the Dodgers.

No one believed they would ever see DePodesta in baseball again.

Besides, when the Browns go 56-99-1 under your watch as their chief strategy officer, and you're directly involved in the disastrous Deshaun Watson trade – sending three first-round picks and giving Watson a five-year, \$230 million contract – a whole lot of folks tend to lose your number.

Well, not the Rockies – with former

Rockies GM Dan O'Dowd running interference – who selected DePodesta after Arizona Diamondbacks assistant GM Amiel Sawdaye was offered the job, and rejected it, because of family reasons.

Now, here DePodesta is, after failing to obtain the next Holy Grail of sports and lead the Browns to their first Super Bowl championship, he's trying to get the Rockies their first World Series title.

"I'm rooting for both," DePodesta says. "I'll actually take them in either order, as long as they both happen pretty quickly ..."

What would be the biggest miracle?

"I don't know if I'll ever see that day, but I hope it's the Browns," said Peter Bendix, the Marlins president of baseball operations and a Cleveland native. "I'm just very happy for him. When I first got this job (two years) ago, Paul didn't know me, but he was extremely supportive. He gave me calls, texts, and said, 'Let me know if I can be helpful.' And he meant it. He had no reason to be that way and he was. That's just who he is as a person."

Certainly, DePodesta needs all of the help he can get considering he's taking over a team that lost an MLB-worst 119 games, lost 100 or more games three consecutive years, finished last or next-to-last seven consecutive seasons, and has never won the NL West in the franchise's 33-year history.

And you thought that the Browns, with three winning seasons since 2002, have their troubles?

"I'm a sucker for a challenge," DePodesta said.

He's at the base of Mount Everest

wearing flip-flops trying to get the Rockies to even earn a playoff berth in the monstrous NL West.

So really, why come back?

He received a few calls in the first five years of his departure from baseball but said there never was a compelling reason for him to walk away from the Browns. He was ecstatic in 2020 that he was responsible for helping hire a GM and head coach and received a five-year extension.

It was only the past few years where he felt the itch of returning to baseball one last time.

"It wasn't a situation where I was like, looking to leave by any stretch," DePodesta said, "but over the last couple of years I had thought about at least the possibility of coming back, you know, what might be next. But it really would have to be sort of the right situation. That right situation includes challenge."

Certainly, it helped that the Rockies had several folks like O'Dowd, Sandy Alderson and Billy Beane lobbying for him. He spent years in the NL West working for the Padres and the Dodgers. And he lived in La Jolla, California, and was willing to move to Denver.

Now, he has the burden of trying to get back up to speed in a game that's dramatically changed the past 10 years. Batting average is out, OPS is in. Strikeouts are accepted, home runs are awesome. Launch angle and exit velocity are the new talk, while complete games and .300 hitters are obsolete.

"I was always trying to keep abreast of what was happening in baseball," DePodesta said, "maybe not to the extent that I was when I was working full-time, but I was still interested in everything that was going on."

Now, he's responsible for taking a pitching staff that yielded an MLB-worst 6.65 ERA, a lineup filled with kids, and a \$182 million albatross in Kris Bryant, and expected to miraculously compete with the Dodgers.

Watson may win the Walter Payton Man of the Year award before the Rockies ever topple the Dodgers.

The Rockies aren't going to ever outspend the Dodgers. They aren't ever going to have more talent than the Dodgers. But, hey, when you spend a decade with the Browns, you get a few ideas.

"I'll say this, I'm very willing to experiment right now and try different things," DePodesta said. "I don't have all of the answers by any stretch."

"But I'm pretty relentless when it

comes to trying to find them. ...

"We have to be willing to try some different things."

He will canvass the thoughts of all those who went before him, those who are still in the organization, those who have been fired and run over, and plans to make it a shared vision.

Some ideas will work, some will blow up in their face, and some will be catastrophic, whether it was the Bryant signing or the Watson trade.

"Most decisions when it comes to significant player decisions ..." DePodesta says, trying to explain the Watson trade, "I consider those to be organizational decisions. So anyone who is within the sort of senior leadership group, we all own those decisions. Every one of them. ..."

"There's a lot we can't share publicly, but there was an incredible amount of diligence that goes into every one of our decisions over the last 10 years, and ultimately, we got to the place where we did."

DePodesta insists he's in this for the long haul. There were plenty of Sunday nights when he wished he had stayed in baseball, but never did he feel like quitting, or feel that he made a mistake. He's taking the same approach now.

"I purposely went back to the learning curve," he said. "What was really hard at the beginning was I went from 20 years in baseball where you're not necessarily great at what you do, I'd been through the cycle enough where I felt confident."

"And then to go to the NFL where I felt decidedly incompetent, and that was going to last for a while. That was hard to get through. But at no point (did) I want to bail on that and say, 'Oh, I should just go back to where I'm comfortable.' No, this is sort of the growth and challenge I was looking for."

Now, here he is again, 10 years later. There will be plenty of cool nights in the Rocky Mountains where he'll feel incompetent again, wonder if he made the wrong decision returning to baseball ... and realize every day that this may be the greatest challenge he'll ever encounter in his life.

Time will tell whether he made the right decision.

And time will tell whether the Rockies will regret hiring him.

Buckle up, this should be one turbulent ride.

Pat Murphy, Stephen Vogt repeat as best managers

MLB managers are often overlooked when it comes to team performance. Many fans believe it all comes down to turning in the lineup card.

In reality, managers are the glue who keeps many clubhouses together. They are tasked with handling myriad personalities and ensuring everyone is all in on making a winning organization.

All six candidates for manager of the year this season led their teams to the postseason. Five led their teams to division titles. And each had a case for their league's hardware.

Milwaukee Brewers manager Pat Murphy was given the award in the National League for the second consecutive season. The Cleveland Guardians' Stephen Vogt won the award in the American League, who also won the



award in 2024. Prior to this season, only two had won back-to-back manager of the year Awards (Bobby Cox, 2004-05; Kevin Cash, 2020-21).

Murphy led the Brewers to the best

record (97-65) in baseball in 2025.

Given how well the Brewers performed, it's hard to remember that they were 0-4 to start the season, tying the 1954 Cardinals for the most runs surren-

dered through the first four games in MLB history.

Murphy's crew bounced back in unbelievable fashion though, rattling off three separate winning streaks of at least eight games between May 25 and Aug. 16.

Murphy earned 27 of the possible 30 first-place votes.

Vogt won the award after leading the Guardians (88-74) to their third AL Central Division title in four years. This year's title felt special though. After selling at the trade deadline, the team went on a massively unexpected run, winning 19 of their last 23 games to steal the AL Central away from the Detroit Tigers.

Cleveland's playoff hopes were all but dashed at the All-Star break, yet Vogt managed to rally his troops and put together a totally unexpected push that knocked off one of the AL's most consistent teams.

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Sanders says he is 'right man' for Colorado

In the past seven months since April, Colorado football coach Deion Sanders has endured cancer surgery, blood-clot surgery, a 3-7 season with three starting quarterbacks and even the announced departure of the man who hired him for the job.

All of this has led to questions about his future at age 58. But Sanders gave a strong statement about that Tuesday Nov. 18 as his team prepares for its final two games this year, starting Saturday night at home against Arizona State.

"Please understand, if anybody is built for adversity, I am," Sanders said at his weekly news conference. "If anybody has built to change, I am. If anybody's built to overcome situations and trials and tribulations, I am. You got the right man. I promise you, you do. And I'm gonna prove that to you. I am. Just give me an opportunity and give me a little more time, and I'm gonna prove that to you. I will. I promise you that."

Colorado safety Ben Finneseth vouched for this Tuesday at the same news conference.

"He's a tough son of a gun, and he'll never quit," Finneseth said. "I don't think he even cares what happens to him, to be honest with you. You can't even tell that he's going through something because he shows up every day with the same attitude."

Sanders also was asked about a recent comment he made in an interview with former NFL star Champ Bailey for TNT. He told Bailey that Colorado coaches "missed on several players" this year, implying certain players didn't live up to expectations.

Sanders said Tuesday he was just being "brutally honest."

"I haven't forgotten how to coach in a year," said Sanders, whose team finished 9-4 in 2024. "Like, I hadn't forgot how to coach in a year. A lot of these wonderful coaches out there that is not winning this season, they had forgotten how to coach in a year. We did some things we shouldn't have done. That's on us."

So how does he correct that in evaluating players for next year?

"God, I can't say what I want to say," Sanders said. "Let me try and give it to you in a way I can say it. I know what I want. I know what I should see. And this year, I'm gonna see it. That's the best way I could place it to you. I'm gonna see it. No ifs, ands or buts about it I'm gonna see what I want to see."

Colorado has been eliminated from postseason eligibility but still has reasons to finish strong. Among the stakes:

- Freshman quarterback Julian "JuJu" Lewis has been given the starting job and plans to burn his redshirt year after playing in three games, including two as a backup quarterback. Under current NCAA rules, players can play in up to four games in one season before they use one of their four seasons of college eligibility. By giving him the keys to the car, Sanders is investing in next year now.

"Like I was telling him is you have a great opportunity and you can show the world right now who you are," Finneseth said about Lewis.

- Sanders wants to show he can right the ship after agreeing to new five-year contract in March worth more than \$10 million annually. His three-year record at Colorado is 16-19. A strong finish would show potential recruits the makings of a turnaround they can join.

Deion Sanders discusses son Shedeur's big NFL moment

Colorado football coach Deion Sanders said Tuesday Nov. 18 he didn't know yet if he'd make it to Las Vegas to watch his son Shedeur's first start as an NFL quarterback.

But Sanders also said he likes quarterback Dillon Gabriel — Shedeur's teammate with the Cleveland Browns — and knows what's been going on "behind the curtains" this season in Cleveland.

Shedeur Sanders, a rookie with the Browns, came off the bench in a 23-16 loss against Baltimore on Sunday after Gabriel, the starting quarterback, suffered a concussion and remains in concussion protocol. Sanders will make his first career start against the Las Vegas Raiders in Week 12. Raiders coach Kevin Stefanski made the announcement Nov. 19.

"Haven't made that decision as of yet," Deion said about going to Las Vegas. "I'm so focused on what we have at hand. I'm not thinking about that, although I just got off the phone with him a minute ago."

Sanders' Colorado team hosts Arizona State in a 8 p.m. ET game Nov. 22. His team is 3-7 and often practices on Sundays.

Deion said he's fond of Gabriel

The father said he was "in tears" after learning in his office in Boulder that his son finally saw his first action in a regular-season game. He said he predicted to Shedeur beforehand that he would play against the Ravens.

"I thought the Ravens would have played better early on to provoke him getting in," Sanders said Tuesday at his weekly news conference in Boulder. "I didn't want him to get in by the

injury because I'm fond of Dillon, and I want him to be successful as well. But I didn't want that to happen."

Deion alludes to issues 'behind the curtains'

Shedeur came back from a fractured back that he suffered at Colorado in 2023 and entered the NFL draft in April as a projected first-round pick. But then he fell to the fifth round and Cleveland, which drafted Gabriel in the third round. Fans of Sanders have questioned why the Browns didn't give him a better chance until Sunday, when he completed 4 of 16 passes for 47 yards with an interception against the Ravens.

"I was happy for him just getting the opportunity and running on that field because I know the fight behind the fight," Deion Sanders said.

"Yeah, if I could say that modestly. I know what's been transpiring behind the curtains, and I'm just proud of him, because he's not just saying the right things, he's doing and living the right things. That's just who he is."

Personic takes protecting PHI seriously. We conducted a diligent investigation to confirm the nature and scope of the incident. In addition, we have taken steps to reduce the likelihood of a similar incident from occurring in the future, and we continue to make additional improvements that strengthen our cybersecurity protections. Although we are unaware of any instances in which the PHI that was subject to unauthorized access and acquisition in this incident has been misused, we are providing individuals with access to 24 months of complimentary credit monitoring and identity protection services.

You must separately place a credit freeze on your credit file at each credit reporting agency. The following information should be included when requesting a credit freeze:

- 1) Full name, with middle initial and any suffixes;
- 2) Social Security number;
- 3) Date of birth (month, day, and year);
- 4) Current address and previous addresses for the past five (5) years;
- 5) Proof of current address, such as a current utility bill or telephone bill; and
- 6) Other personal information as required by the applicable credit reporting agency.

If you request a credit freeze online or by phone, then the credit reporting agencies have one (1) business day after receiving your request to place a credit freeze on your credit file report. If you request a lift of the credit freeze online or by phone, then the credit reporting agency must lift the freeze within one (1) hour. If you request a credit freeze or lift of a credit freeze by mail, then the credit agency must place or lift the credit freeze no later than three (3) business days after getting your request.

Fraud Alerts. You also have the right to place an initial or extended fraud alert on your file at no cost. An initial fraud alert lasts one (1) year and is placed on a consumer's credit file. Upon seeing a fraud alert display on a consumer's credit file, a business is required to take steps to verify the consumer's identity before extending new credit. If you are a victim of identity theft, you are entitled to an extended fraud alert, which is a fraud alert lasting seven (7) years.
