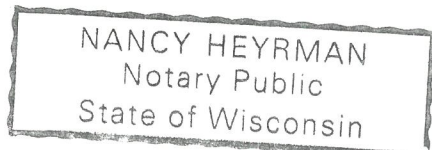





# Dropkin, Thiesse earn silver in curling

CORTINA D'AMPEZZO, Italy – Cory Thiesse and Corey Dropkin are Olympic medalists.

The tandem, known affectionately as “Girl Cory” and “Boy Corey,” won silver in the mixed doubles curling event Tuesday Feb. 10 after falling 6-5 to Sweden in the gold medal match.

The 2026 Winter Olympic Games were the third to include mixed doubles curling, and Thiesse and Dropkin's performance earned Team USA its first-ever medal in the event.

“It's certainly bittersweet. We would have loved to have won the gold today, but it's huge to be on that podium,” Thiesse said. “The whole goal of this team was to make it to the Olympics, and we made it here, and we're going home with a medal. We just can't ask for much more.”

With the Americans in second and the Swedes in first, the Italians rounded out the podium, defeating Great Britain 5-3 in the bronze medal game.

Thiesse and Dropkin defeated Sweden 8-7 in round-robin play to clinch a spot in the semifinals. After dropping their last match of round-robin play to Italy 7-6 Monday morning, they bested the home team 9-8 for a shot at gold. In falling to Sweden on Tuesday, Thiesse and Dropkin finished with a 7-4 overall record.

Their bus was caught in heavy traffic on the way to the game. Thiesse and Dropkin could see Cortina Curling Olympic Stadium from the logjam and

asked the driver if they could just get out and walk. “Luckily he let us,” Thiesse said.

She was adamant the unplanned stroll had no impact on the game and gave a shout-out to sports psychologist Carly Anderson for helping the team “expect the unexpected” this week in the Dolomites.

In the gold medal match, Team USA won the first and third ends 1-0, but a 2-0 Sweden advantage in the second set gave sibling duo Isabella and Rasmus Wranaa the 3-2 edge after four ends. Isabella had a 97% shot success rate heading the break.

A perfectly placed yellow stone in the fifth end pulled Thiesse and Dropkin even 3-3 with the Wranas and prompted “USA” chants from the mostly American crowd. As 20 or so full-sized

American flags billowed in the stands, Dropkin pumped his arms for more.

“We love them, and we loved having them here cheering us on,” Dropkin said. “Because, who knows what would have happened without them? It helped energize me and helped energize us, and it just added to how surreal the environment out there was. Everyone who came out to support their team, not just from the U.S., but Team Sweden, the Italians that were out there, the Swiss, the Great British folks. I mean, it was an amazing atmosphere. And it adds to just the moment and how special this whole week has been.”

Team USA took a 5-4 lead into the eighth end after getting two on the board in the seventh. The Americans weren't as accurate as the Swedes, putting together a shot success percentage

of 73% to their 83%. But the margin was much closer in take-outs, with a 70% shot success metric for the U.S. and 72% for Sweden.

Thiesse and Dropkin's second-to-last stone of the eighth end had too much power behind it, sliding past the button, which meant their last stone had to be perfect. It did knock the Swedes' red stone off the middle, but they had the final stone of the game.

Their silver medal is a culmination of two lifetimes on the ice. Thiesse, 31, and Dropkin, 30, came up in the sport together, at first succeeding separately. Each won their first junior national title in 2012 and their first senior national title nine years later.

In April 2022, Dropkin asked Thiesse for a drink at Pickwick Restaurant & Pub in Duluth, Minnesota. The establishment, owned by two national champion curlers Tim and Amy Wright, is where Dropkin asked Thiesse to be his doubles partner. A year later, they became the first U.S. mixed doubles pair to win a world championship.

Now, they're Olympic medalists. Where will the mercury-testing lab technician and Realtor keep their new hardware?

“That's a great question, I have not thought about yet,” Thiesse said.

“Right now,” Dropkin chimed in, “it's around my neck. And it's gonna stay there for a little while.”

Thiesse agreed: “Might sleep with it for a little while.”

## ASHLEY FARQUHARSON RIDES TO U.S. HISTORY



Ashley Farquharson became the second U.S. woman and first in 12 years to win an Olympic medal in luge Tuesday, Feb. 10, in Cortina D'Ampezzo, Italy. She finished third in the women's single event at the Cortina Sliding Center with a time of 3:31.582. This bronze performance tied the best finish in program history, as the USA's only other medal in women's luge was Erin Hamlin's bronze in 2014. Farquharson, 26, has been sliding since age 11. She entered the final two of four runs in fifth but powered into third with a 52.877 seconds in the third run and held her spot with a 53.909 in her fourth.

## USA TODAY hockey experts size up field

The NHL is back at the Winter Olympics.

The league is sending its players for the first time since 2014. Though Finland is the defending champion after winning gold in Beijing in 2022, Canada is the star of the NHL era from 1998 to 2014.

The country won gold in 2002, 2010 and 2014, and Pittsburgh Penguins and Team Canada captain Sidney Crosby is looking to pick up his third gold medal. Sweden (2006) and the Czech Republic (1998) are the other winners in the NHL era.

So, who will skate off with a gold medal after the championship game on Feb. 22? USA TODAY asked for predictions for the gold, silver and bronze medal. Here is what our experts said:

Canada is the best of the best-on-best era. It hasn't lost such a tournament since the 2006 Games, capturing two Olympics, the 2016 World Cup of Hockey and last year's 4 Nations Face-Off. Team Canada is oozing with talent, featuring the top three NHL scorers who are at the Olympics. If the Canadians can get decent goaltending, they will be the best again.

## 'Blade Angels' fall to Earth, but hope for Liu

MILAN – American hopes were sky high coming into the Olympic women's figure skating competition. Could there be a U.S. sweep of the medals? Would the 20-year U.S. medal drought finally end? Who would be the breakout star among the trio known on social media as the Blade Angels: Amber Glenn, Alysa Liu and Isabeau Levito?

Then they all skated the short program Feb. 17, and two of the "Angels" fell back to earth, becoming so upset they didn't stop to speak to waiting journalists – in stark contrast with how Ilia Malinin handled his horrible long program Feb. 13.

Liu, 20, the reigning world champion, was the one who did answer reporters' questions after a terrific short program that landed her in third place, a perfect position for her going into the deciding long program Feb. 19.

"It just humbles me so much and I'm just really grateful for it all, the good and the bad," she said. "I want to keep growing. I just want to keep experiencing new things."

Levito, 18, also skated quite well in her first appearance in these Games but finished in eighth due to the plethora of well-skated programs ahead of her.

But Glenn, the reigning three-time

U.S. champion, made a massive mistake in her short program, popping her planned triple loop into a double, which then received no points because the jump must be a triple, dropping her into 13th place overall. That happened after she landed the best triple Axel of the evening, which made her error all the more devastating.

Glenn, 26, broke into tears when she finished her program and was doubled over, crying, as she received her scores. A U.S. Figure Skating spokesperson said Glenn would not be speaking to reporters. Meanwhile, Levito just walked by the assembled U.S. journalists without stopping for reasons unknown.

While sadness enveloped the American trio, there was nothing but joy for the incredibly deep Japanese team. Ami Nakai, an entertaining 17-year-old with a triple Axel to die for, won the short program with 78.71 points, just ahead of veteran countrywoman Kaori Sakamoto, the three-time world champion and 2022 Olympic bronze medalist, who finished with 77.23. Liu was next with 76.59 points, followed by the third member of the Japanese team, Mone Chiba with 74.00. If anyone is sweeping the medals in this event, it's Japan.

Meanwhile, the fallout for the Americans is clear: With the quality of skaters ahead of them, both Levito and Glenn are all but out of the medal hunt. But Liu? She's right where she wants to be.

## U.S. 2nd in team sprint in cross-country skiing

MILAN – Entering the 2026 Winter Games, Team USA had won four cross-country skiing medals in Olympic history.

The Americans have nearly matched that in Milan Cortina alone after picking up another medal.

Team USA claimed silver in the men's team sprint free Feb. 18. Ben Ogden and Gus Schumacher posted a time of 18:30.35 for the U.S. cross-country skiing team's third podium finish after Jessie Diggins claimed bronze in the women's 10 kilometer and Ogden won bronze in the individual sprint.

In team sprint, each pairing is made up of two athletes who alternate laps. In the final round, teams start at the same time and complete six total laps (three per team member).

Whoever crosses the finish line first wins.

Ogden and Schumacher finished 1.37 seconds off the top pace of Norway. Italy claimed the bronze medal.

Norwegian sensation Johannes Høsflot Klæbo won another gold medal

with partner Einar Hedegart with a time of 18:28.98.

Klæbo has won gold in every men's cross-country event so far at the 2026 Winter Games, with one more event to go.

Klæbo improves to 10 total gold medals and joins Michael Phelps (23) as the only Olympians, Summer or Winter, to reach double-digit gold medals.

This silver medal is the second of the 2026 Games for Ogden. He also captured silver in the men's sprint classic, finishing with a time of 3:40.61, less than a second behind Norwegian star Johannes Høsflot Klæbo.

Norway's Oskar Opstad Vike finished with the bronze medal with a time of 3:46.55.

Ogden's silver in the classic sprint ended a nearly 50-year Olympic medal drought for the American men. He became just the second American man to win an Olympic cross-country skiing medal and the first one to make the podium since Bill Koch captured silver in 30K at the 1976 Innsbruck Winter Olympics.

Now, Ogden and Schumacher have added another entry to the American history books.

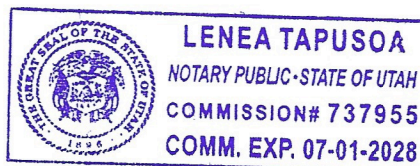
