The findings of the Proposal Evaluation Committee are summarized as follows:

The Proposal Evaluation Committee used the Sourcewell RFP evaluation criteria and determined that all proposal responses met Level-One Responsiveness. Proposals from The Tools Man, Inc. and Certified Stainless Service, Inc. dba West-Mark, Inc. were deemed Level-Two non-responsive because their products were out of scope and not evaluated. All other proposals were found to be Level-Two responsive and were evaluated.

Bandit Industries, Inc. manufactures a wide variety of equipment for this category. Bandit has a strong discount and leasing options available. Their electric powered models are available for those agencies that require less noise and pollution. With their 200 worldwide dealers-they can service Sourcewell members should the need arise.
